LENTEN DISCIPLINES

Dear Gloria Dei family,

"Receive the sign of the cross..." (Philippians 3:10) Those are the first words that begin our Lenten Journey with Jesus to the cross. We hear them on Ash Wednesday and they remind us of our baptism - "marked with the cross of Christ forever." Martin Luther encouraged us to make the sign of the cross in order to remember our baptism daily. As Bill Jonas recently reminded me, 'It's not I was baptized, but I am baptized.' So, why not make the sign of the cross each day during Lent, to remember that you are loved to death.

"Receive the sign of the cross that henceforth you may know the Lord..." One of the traditional disciplines in terms of knowing the Lord, that is as old as Christianity itself is through worshiping together. Worshiping alone is wonderful, but Jesus promises His presence in community - "where two or three are gathered." Lent is the time to journey together. I need you. You need me. God has created us for fellowship. Make both Wednesdays and Sunday worship part of your Lenten discipline.

"Receive the sign of the cross that henceforth you may know the Lord, the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His suffering." We gaze intently upon the cross because that love leads to an empty tomb. All humans know suffering (As I write this, I'm thinking of our good friend Ken Anderson), but because of the cross and only because of the cross we know grace. And grace changes everything - even death to life.

Pastor Sabrina's Dei Light

When I was younger my parents had a cleaning woman, who was also a sort-of babysitter for my sister and me. I loved her, but what I didn't love was the fact that my mom made us all clean the day before she would come to clean each week. I couldn't ever understand that. Of course, now I realize that sometimes it is necessary to tidy up before someone can come in and do a really deep cleaning.

In some ways, that is what Lent is all about. We observe the Lenten season because it gives us the chance to tidy up a little bit, to step outside of our routine and our daily existence and to look closely at our lives, at our choices, at our priorities. The season of Lent grants us the opportunity to reflect on

whether we are making plenty of room for God in our lives or whether we are trying to squeeze God in when it's convenient and easy. It makes us think about the sacrifice that Jesus made – not in a negative, guilt-inducing kind of way; instead, Lent makes us think about the sacrifice that Jesus made in a grace-filled, life-giving, forgiveness is guaranteed, kind of way.

We go into the Lenten season knowing that it is a finite 40-day journey that will end with Easter morning. We may make changes or sacrifices, but we do so knowing that resurrection is coming. How good it is to know that God's light shines even in our darkest times.

This Lent, we are working through the Stations of the Cross. Maybe a good place to begin is this meditation by former Pope, Benedict the XVI, as he reflected on the cross:

"Brothers and sisters, our gaze is frequently distracted by scattered and passing earthly interests; let us direct our gaze today toward Christ. Let us pause to contemplate his Cross. The Cross is the source of immortal life, the school of justice and peace, the universal patrimony of pardon and mercy... His nailed arms are open to each human being and they invite us to draw near to him, certain that he accepts us and clasps us in an embrace of infinite tenderness: 'I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself" (Jn 12: 32).

The Concordia Choir of Moorhead, Minn., continues to affirm its reputation as one of America's finest a cappella choirs. Since 1920, the 72-voice choir has performed in nearly every major hall including Carnegie Hall and Kennedy Center as well as numerous international tours.

A February 2010 performance and recording session with the Grammy Award-winning King's Singers and multiple performances on Garrison Keillor's "Prairie Home Companion" radio show highlight the Choir's world-class quality. In May 2011 the choir toured South Korea and performed with Dr. Hak Won Yoon's Incheon City Chorale.

The Concordia Choir is featured in the Emmy-winning Concordia Christmas Concerts, which are nationally broadcast on public

television. The choir's recordings are distributed internationally and through iTunes, making it one of the top-selling choirs in the country.

Dr. René Clausen is the third conductor in the choir's illustrious history, assuming the role in 1986. As a composer he has written more than 120 commissioned works. The Kansas City Chorale recording "Life and Breath: Choral Works by René Clausen" won two Grammy awards in 2013.

This year's 2017 national tour of the Southwest spans 15 days and includes locations between Minneapolis and Los Angeles.
