# Pastor Sabrina's Dei Light

Genesis 8:22: "As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night will never cease."

What a perfect passage to reflect on in the season of Easter and as spring gets into full swing. During this time of year, when new flowers are blooming and the sun is shining late into the evening, it seems to me that God is everywhere I look. It's hard to believe that anyone could deny God's existence? God has been coloring and changing our scenery in beautiful ways since the beginning of time.

No matter how bad the news on TV is, sometimes seeing the colors of spring, smelling the smells of new grass and flowers, hearing the birds, feeling the sunshine - all of this is a gentle reminder that God is alive and in control.

From where I sit in the sanctuary during Sunday service, I can see a bird's nest outside on the windowsill above the organ. The season of Easter stretches from Easter Sunday until June 17th. It is a full 50 days to explore, savor, and relish the idea of the resurrection and its implications. As we breathe in the freshness of springtime, as we observe the life being re-born all around you, let us not forget to give thanks to the one who always gives us hope.


