How to pick up a Bible and read it intelligently...

<u>7 principles:</u>

1. Exegesis - a critical method... "Shelf" principle.

2. "Think Hebrew." Eastern (Hebraic)

Western (Greek) Cultures

3. Limitation Principle... The Bible is not interested in every question... There is a limit, but not a limit to God! Lutheran confessions do not use the word "inerrant" when talking about the Bible...

4. The Bible is a historical document. It is written in history... **Contextual interpretation...**

5. Literary Principle... (Form/Source Criticism)

6. The Lens by which we see: Justification by faith; Law and Gospel, the Word of God... (Jesus). The Bible is God's Word because we meet the Word.

7. Scriptura sui ipsius interpres **(Scripture is its own interpreter).** Luther - the plain meaning of Scripture...
