Dear Gloria Dei family,

We're in the middle of the Season of Lent - this 40 day pilgrimage to the cross. Some of you have given things up - a reminder to pray, a prompt to consider others. My thanks to Pastor Sabrina for arranging the traveling art exhibit.

My focus is on our upcoming theme: **Gen2Gen** (Generation to Generation). We want everything we do to consider - is this good for the children in our midst and the people yet to come? One of the world's greatest writers, Antoine de Saint-Exupery (The Little Prince) put it best:

In a house which becomes a home, one hands down and another takes up the heritage of mind and heart, laughter and tears, musings and deeds. Love, like a carefully loaded ship, crosses the gulf between the generations. Therefore, we do not neglect the ceremonies of our passage: when we wed, when we die, and when we are blessed with a child; When we depart and when we return; When we plant and when we harvest. Let us bring up our children. It is not the place of some official to hand to them their heritage. If others impart to our children our knowledge and ideals, they will lose all of us that is wordless and full of wonder. Let us build memories in our children, lest they drag out joyless lives, lest they allow treasures to be lost because they have not been given the keys. We live, not by things, but by the meanings of things. It is needful to transmit the passwords from generation to generation.

The Holiest of Holy Weeks

Lent is a wonderful time of reflection, perhaps small sacrifices, and remembrance. But just as important is Holy Week, the week before Easter beginning with Palm Sunday and continuing with services on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. The description of the Holy Week service is as follows:

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week. We rejoice with the crowds as Jesus enters into the city of Jerusalem, waving palms and shouting "Hosanna!" All of our worship services will begin outside, followed by a procession into the sanctuary. Worship on March 25 at 8:30am, 10:30am, and 5:00pm.

Maundy Thursday takes its name from the Latin word for "commandment," as we remember when Jesus told his disciples, "A new commandment I give to you: Love one another." This day marks the official end of Lent. We also remember the first Lord's Supper and the washing of the disciples' feet. Worship on March 29 at 7:00pm.

Good Friday commemorates the day when our Lord gave his life to save us from our sins. It is a very humbling service, as we contemplate the cost that Jesus paid for our redemption. The service is a "tenebrae" service, which comes from the Latin meaning "darkness." It makes use of gradually diminishing light through the extinguishing of candles to symbolize the approaching darkness of Jesus' death and of hopelessness in the world without God. The service concludes in darkness with a final candle, the Christ candle, carried out of the sanctuary, symbolizing the death of Jesus. Worship on March 30 at 12:00pm and 7:00pm.

A TRAVELING EXHIBIT FROM CHRISTIANS IN THE VISUALS ARTS GLORIA DEI is hosting a national traveling art exhibit called "Come to the Table"...

The exhibit is made available through CIVA | Christians in the Visual Arts, a non-profit founded in 1979 dedicated to exploring and nurturing the relationship between the visual arts and the Christian faith. It is on display in Bankson Hall right now.

COME TO THE TABLE features thirty-five carefully selected works including historical pieces by Albrecht Durer, modernist work by Jasper Johns and Sadao Watanabe, fresh contemporary pieces created by CIVA-member artists. This work, executed in a variety of media, celebrates both the rich community gathered at the Table of Fellowship and the privilege of meeting with God at his Table of Communion. From Abraham entertaining angels, to Christ's Last Supper with his disciples, to the great Marriage Feast of the Lamb at the end of time, the table is a rich biblical metaphor. Indeed, the promise of Revelation 19 is that human history will culminate around a table where the people of God are all present. God's Table is a place of welcome, justice, abundance, and worship.
