There are two kinds of fools in the world: damned fools and what Saint Paul calls "fools for Christ's sake" (1 Corinthians 4:10).

Lent 2018 will be focused on a traveling art exhibit and observed with an emphasis upon traditional disciplines - fasting, prayer, almsgiving - but we'll also laugh, smile, and give thanks to God for love and all those people placed in our lives that show us such grace.

An Ashy Lent

After the recent and tragic wildfires and resulting mudslides in California, I have a different picture of Ash Wednesday in my mind this year. I have a picture of a family returning to their completely blackened and destroyed home, sifting through the burned out rubble for any surviving pieces of memento. I have a picture of large swaths of previously green and lush land flattened and dark from ashy remnants of plants and grass and trees.

It may seem that ash is a reminder of what is lost. But that's not all it is. Thinking about this year, in particular, I also have a picture of the firefighters taking brief snatches of sleep outside in the elements, still fully dressed in their gear, still covered in ash and soot, because they are going right back to their work. I have a picture in my mind of the generosity of Gloria Dei during our Thanksgiving worship in giving to Fire Assistance through Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Santa Rosa.

There is a great quote that I remember from a book I read a long time ago called *Gilead*, by Marilynne Robinson. It is the story of a 76-year-old Iowa pastor, reflecting on his life for the sake of his young son, born to him in his old age. At one point, he and the other men in the town help to take down a church that had been struck by lightning. He returns to his family covered in ash from head to feet. But he says to his son, "Never mind, there's nothing cleaner than ash."

Personally, I think that is a great way to think about Ash Wednesday. It is a reminder that because of Christ's sacrifice on the cross, we are cleaner now than we were before because not only do we have hope – the hope of forgiveness and eternal life – but we are also called to give hope to those in need around us. On this Ash Wednesday let us remember that we don't serve a God of loss but rather a God of abundance who is with us and continues to provide for us in times of plenty and also in times of need.




LIVING A GENEROUS LIFE

LENT - COME TO THE TABLE



GLORIA DEI will be hosting a national traveling art exhibit called "Come to the Table" ...

Beginning on Ash Wednesday, February 14th. The exhibit is made available through CIVA|Christians in the Visual Arts, a non-profit founded in 1979 dedicated to exploring and nurturing the relationship between the visual arts and the Christian faith.

COME TO THE TABLE features thirty-five carefully selected works including historical pieces by Albrecht Durer, modernist work by Jasper Johns and Sadao Watanabe, fresh contemporary pieces created by CIVA-member artists. This work, executed in a variety of media, celebrates both the rich community gathered at the Table of Fellowship and the privilege of meeting with God at his Table of Communion. From Abraham entertaining angels, to Christ's Last Supper with his disciples, to the great Marriage Feast of the Lamb at the end of time, the table is a rich biblical metaphor. Indeed, the promise of Revelation 19 is that human history will culminate around a table where the people of God are all present. God's Table is a place of welcome, justice, abundance, and worship.


