Spring is Blooming

One of the best things about spring are the plants... the beautiful flowers, colors, and blooms that we see all around us. In order for anything to grow, it needs three essential ingredients: sun, water, and good soil. With those three things, a seed can grow into a plant and a plant can grow into its full potential. And sometimes, in addition to sun, water, and good soil, we need a little patience. I planted a garden in the backyard patio area of the condo about six years ago. One of the plants I planted was a dwarf grapefruit tree. It has always been healthy, green, and flowering, but for four years, it yielded no grapefruit. I thought about taking it out, but every year I decided to just give it one more

year. Then, last year, it yielded a large crop of huge grapefruit. The rinds were thick, but the fruit was tasty. This year, the fruit was even better with smaller rinds. I have every hope that next year will be better still.

In many ways, one of the most important jobs of the church is planting and nourishing seeds. We plant seeds of faith. As a community, we all participate in nourishing those seeds with fellowship, prayer, Bible study, worship, and outreach. Patience is also necessary here because we are all busy, because we don't always see the results of our service work, and because it takes times for one's relationship with Jesus to grow.

I see the fruit of growth in our congregation all the time. This spring, I see it in the confirmation class. Five 8th graders will be confirmed at the end of May after three years of classes, meetings, and retreats. I see it in the children who participate in children's messages, Sunday school, and children's choir at church. I see it in the interactions between members, specifically intergenerational as we celebrated Gen2Gen in April. I see it in the fellowship of the men's and women's ministries and church dinners and picnics. I see it in the compassion of service projects such as Serra's Pantry, Los Angelitos, and the Saturday Homeless Engagement Center.

Psalm 1:3 reads, "They are like trees planted by streams of water, which yield their fruit in its season, and their leaves do not wither. In all that they do, they prosper." May we pray for God's continued work in our congregation and the blooming of ministries.
