Dear Gloria Dei family,

Whatever it takes. Similar to what St. Paul wrote: *I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some. I do all this for the sake of the gospel...* (1 Corinthians 9:22-23)

Which means, we keep praying, working, making adjustments, so that we might do things a little better and we might reach one more person. With that in mind, I'm offering the following tweaks.

- Time change: In the fall, we will keep the current schedule - 8:30am, 10:00am, and 5pm.
- But what about Sunday school? For children, preschool through 5th grade, we will offer this at both morning service times. Early in the service, children will be invited to go with Barb Collins and other teachers to their classes and return during Holy Communion. Music will be taught, a craft, and a lesson connecting the message of the day. Of course, children can stay with parents for the entire service or go to one service and attend Sunday school at the next service time - lots of options.
- What about Confirmation and Adult Education? We will begin a new learning opportunity, once a month - "L&L" - Lunch and Learn. This will take place at 11am, once/month. In Pastor Sabrina's article, the details of this program, including outside speakers and themes will be highlighted. This will improve our fellowship time, learning, and give great outside speakers a few more minutes.

Please join me in praying for the enthusiasm and Spirit to make things work for *Gloria Dei* - Glory of God.

Fall in Faith, Lunch & Learn, Confirm not Conform

Change is in the air. I'm sure we can all feel it as summer comes to a close and fall stands right around the corner, ready to wrap us up in the scent of pumpkin, the deeper darker colors of flower plants, and the hint of cooler weather (I hope!). At Gloria Dei, fall means a time for reorienting ourselves to God and recommitting ourselves to our faith. You have all heard or even said yourselves, "I fell in love." During this season at Gloria Dei, I think we all need to take the chance to "fall in faith." Some of our recommitment to God is about seeking out those faith-forming opportunities, whether it is fellowship events or Bible studies or outreach activities, that are available.

In addition to falling into faith, this Fall at Gloria Dei there are two programs that I am especially excited about. One is "L&L" - Lunch and Learning. Because the service times are not changing, there will be no time for adult education in between services this year. Instead, we will be having a "L&L" - Lunch and Learning opportunity for adults on the first Sunday of every month from October through May. L&L will involve - you guessed it - lunch! During the meal, there will be a special speaker or other learning opportunity. It will run from 11:00-12:30 once a month. In October, L&L will kick off with lunch (of course) and guest speaker Becks Heyhoe from the United Way, speaking about the organization's very interesting approach to homelessness through the "United to End Homelessness" campaign in Orange County.

While the adults are L&Ling, middle school students will be participating in a new Confirmation program called *Confirm not Conform*. The Confirmation program will also take place on the first Sunday of every month from 11:00-1:00. It will also involve lunch (we have to feed the people!), as well as outreach, lessons, visits to other faith communities, and guest speakers.




Nov. 4 - Pastor David Mattson, “4DM”



Members of the Columbarium Committee have met with City planning staff, and it is anticipated that the application will be scheduled for a public hearing later this year.

Proximity makes it convenient for loved ones to visit and remain connected. The cost of columbarium interment is also considerably less than the cost of burial at a cemetery.
