Dear Gloria Dei family,

Second, **Lenten Hymn Madness** - I hope you've enjoyed thinking about great hymns during this season? Did your favorite hymns advance? My choice for ultimate winning hymn was **"Jesus Christ is Risen Today"**. It lost early on, but not the message and the power of it! A couple thoughts about this hymn and Easter.

First, please enter the Easter joy fully! I believe that happens through **observing Holy Week deeply**. With the Palm Waving of Palm Sunday to the darkness of Good Friday, those contrasts prepare us for Easter.

Second, remember that all important word **"is."** Jesus Christ is risen today. And we'll shout on Easter, "Christ is risen! He is risen today!" Easter is a present tense reality. The love of God is to transform us today - to help us battle the darkness (inside and outside) today.

Third, there's always **hope**. When I'm battered by difficulties of the day (month, year...), this one event brings strength. God promises to bring life to the dead through Jesus.

Finally, sing it out loudly. It's not a song to sing softly. That is, it's too good to keep to ourselves. Pick up a flier with the Easter schedule and share it with a someone. This is a song, for all people. Let's share.

## Pastor Sabrina's Dei Light Wondrous Love, Wondrous Hymns

Throughout the month of April, until Easter, we will be continuing our Lenten sermon series, "Lent Hymn Madness", thinking about the great hymns of our faith. There are so many great hymns and so many we won't get a chance to preach on. So I thought I would write a short meditation on one of those great hymns that we usually sing during Holy Week, *What Wondrous Love Is This*.

This hymn was first included in a collection of hymns in 1835, but it was around for many years before that, passed down orally rather than written down. It's origin is not known, but it was believed to have been composed in the Appalachian region of America in the early 1800s.

*What Wondrous Love Is This* causes us to meditate on these beautiful lines: "What wondrous love is this that caused the Lord of bliss, to bear the dreadful curse, for my soul, for my soul, to bear the dreadful curse for my soul." During Holy Week, especially, we focus on Christ's sacrifice on the cross, and as we do so, we think about our own humanity, our sins, and our guilt. We cannot help but feel a sense of somberness and awe at God's enormous love for us, even though we don't deserve it.

The last lines of the hymn are these: "And when from death I'm free, I'll sing and joyful be, And thro' eternity, I'll sing on, I'll sing on, And thro' eternity, I'll sing on." This beautiful hymn is contemplative, but we also sing with joy and with hope as we remember the purpose of Christ's death on the cross: the resurrection of Jesus and the life he gave to all people. What an amazing reminder as we walk through Holy Week toward the joy of Easter Sunday!





When she was much younger she lived at Los Angelitos. But since she was 13 she has been living at a government institution for homeless children. Several times in the past two years she asked if she could return to Los Angelitos but the orphanage did not have sufficient funds for her living expenses; school tuition, books, healthcare, etc.

Then, last December, Gloria Dei provided a year-long scholarship for Abigail. This was made possible because of the generosity of many from our congregation. Abigail is now living at Los Angelitos and is so grateful.

Abigail is in high school - studying hard and getting good grades. When she finishes high school she wants to go to college to study criminal justice. After graduation she wants to be a law enforcement investigator.
