Dear Gloria Dei family,

We continue our summer series on **The Sermon on the Mount - The Upside Down/Inside Out Kingdom**. It begins with the Beatitudes: *"Blessed are you..."* Not, blessed are you, if you do this or that or, blessed are you, if you don't do this or that. It all starts with blessing, in other words, it begins with God's blessing - grace.

In preparation for this series, I'm recalling words by author Anne Lamott: "Grace is spiritual WD-40, or water wings... The movement of grace is what changes us, heals us and heals our world. To summon grace, say, 'Help,' and then buckle up. Grace finds you exactly where you are, but it doesn't leave you where it found you. And grace won't look like Casper the Friendly Ghost, regrettably. But the phone will ring or the mail will come and then against all odds, you'll get your sense of humor about yourself back. Laughter really is carbonated holiness. It helps us breathe again and again and gives us back to ourselves, and this gives us faith in life and each other. And remember -- grace always bats last..."

Jesus begins The Sermon on the Mount with blessing, with grace. He then goes on to show us all grace - through His life, death, and resurrection. His unconditional love is not only the *"WD-40 or water wings,"* grace is also the power and the energy "to be merciful, the peacemakers, to hunger and thirst for righteousness..."

But it all starts with grace, again, and again, and again...

## Pastor Sabrina's Dei Light

### The Heart of Light


One of my kids' favorite songs to sing right now is *This Little Light of Mine*. It has action (hold up your fingers like a really bright light). It has shouting ("Hide it under a bushel? No!"). It has repetitiveness ("Let it shine, let it shine, let it shine").

As I began preparing for our summer sermon series on The Sermon on the Mount from Matthew 5, I was reminded of this "children's" song that is actually really a great song for all of us, no matter our age. Jesus' Sermon on the Mount contains one of my favorite verses in all of scripture:

*"You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven" (Matthew 5:14-16).*

That last verse is one that we quote during every single baptism. But it does beg the question: How are we supposed to let our light shine? How much light should we be shining? And how do we know if our light is bright enough?

Like everything that Jesus says during this most beautiful sermon, the point is not the literalness of the words but rather the heart behind the words. Just like The Beatitudes, we aren't supposed to take Jesus' words and use them as a measuring stick for our lives. What matters is what – or should I say who – is the motivation behind our thoughts and our actions. Light and brightness is only possible because of the Creator. If we want to be a light in our world, we can only do so with the help of Christ. Just like light changes the way things look around us – whether it is a lamp lighting a room or the rising sun lighting up our world – when we live our life with Christ at the center, we will also change the way things look in our environment. It's not about the amount of light or brightness; it is all about who is creating that light in our lives to begin with. That is the heart of the matter.

## PRESCHOOL


(All things related to the Gloria Dei Lutheran Preschool)

**Q: When do we leave and return?** - Departure @ 7:00 AM & return the same day around 6:00 PM.


**Q: What will we do there?** - This not a construction project. We play with the children: craft projects, piñatas, singing and music, make lunch for everyone, sports and games, etc.

**COLUMBARIUM COMMITTEE** - Gloria Dei has submitted an application to the City of Dana Point, requesting permission to install columbarium niches in the Outdoor Chapel and Contemplation Garden area. Members of the Columbarium Committee have met with City planning staff, and a public hearing at the City of Dana Point will occur July 3.

A growing number of local churches provide or plan to provide columbarium niches on their grounds. People increasingly choose a local columbarium because of a strong desire to be laid to rest on the grounds of the church they loved and served. Proximity makes it convenient for loved ones to visit and remain connected. The cost of columbarium interment is also considerably less than the cost of burial at a cemetery.


