Pastor Sabrina's Dei Light How often do you give thanks?

As we move into Thanksgiving season, I invite us all to live with this truth: "If the only prayer you ever say in your entire life is thank you, it will be enough."

—Meister Eckhart

What's to stop us from praying all the time? Why not say "thank you" throughout the day? When we say thank you, in prayer, silently, to someone else - a friend or a

stranger - it doesn't mean that we have forgotten that there are real needs, real pain, and real suffering in our world or in our lives. What it does mean is that we become more aware of God at work, in the midst of both the good and the bad that we encounter on a daily basis.

Our world seems to want us to believe that we can only be happy when we either have a lot of physical possessions or have a concrete plan to accumulate them very soon. That's why companies spend so much money on advertising. They are able to persuade people that if only they had the latest toy, or car, or household appliance, there will be joy in their lives. Or only if they have time and money for fancy vacations and exotic trips can they experience peace and happiness.

But as Christians, we know that real joy doesn't come from possessions at all. Real joy comes from taking time to look around and give thanks for what we have already, including our very lives, the love of family and friends, and the beauty of the earth around us. Real gratitude comes from remembering all that Christ has blessed us with and all that Christ will continue to bless us with. These blessings aren't things that we can go out and buy, and they are certainly not things that we can hope to achieve on our own. Rather, these blessings have simply been given to us - completely undeserved - because Christ loves us that much.

When we become aware of God's presence with us, we can then figure out what we should do in our lives and what we can do for others. One way to become aware of God's presence in our world is to pray. And, "if the only prayer you ever say in your entire life is thank you, it will be enough."


