Pastor Sabrina's Dei Light Hopeful Waiting

Romans 8:24-25 *"For in this hope we were saved. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what they already have? But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently."*

Advent, the season before Christmas, is one of waiting and preparation. We wait for the coming of the Savior. We prepare, not just for the birth of the baby Jesus, but also for Jesus to come again in glory. Waiting and preparing. Waiting and preparing. But I would add one more action that we engage in during this beautiful season of Advent – hoping.

Paul sums it up best when he says in his letter to the Romans, "if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently." As we wait and as we prepare, we also hope. God has given us great reason to hope. The story of Christ's birth is wonderful. There is the powerful message of the angels, "Fear not, for behold I bring you good tidings of great joy to all people." There is the terribly sad account of Jesus' suffering and death for us, and the awesome victory of his resurrection. And there is the promise that Christ will come again to establish God's Kingdom on earth once and for all.

I would like to say that it is easy to wait patiently for something that we are hoping for so fervently. But let's be honest. We are not a patient generation. As a mom of toddlers, patience is not something that is displayed very often in our home. In fact, one of my kids' favorite books is called *Waiting is Not Easy*. It's a book my husband and I pull out quite often to remind them that it is difficult – *but so worth it!* – to wait for something truly great! During the holiday season, when waiting seems even more tortuous than usual, we have been pulling it out almost every day.

Waiting is not easy. And none of us are always patient – no matter how old we are! We might want to speed past the waiting process, but there is value to waiting, especially waiting in hope. The season of Advent teaches us to slow down and enjoy all that God is doing. While we are waiting, God is working in us. While we are hoping, God is working through us to reach other people who need to know that hope, too.


