Not Your Typical Easter

A lot has changed since the Gloria Dei March newsletter came out. And I don't think the changes are over. I am so grateful for all of the ways that this congregation is staying connected throughout all of the difficulties of virtual worship, not to mention the difficulties that each and every person is undergoing personally, whether it's having children at home that would normally be at school or financial concerns, canceled trips or weddings, feeling isolated and alone, or being sick and scared. We are all in this together, but at the same time, we are all a little bit more alone than we used to be, at least physically.

One of the hardest things I have been dealing with is how to teach and preach the message of the Gospel when there is no one nearby to hear it. Notwithstanding the amazing technology of Zoom and Google meetings and virtual-everything, it's not the same. It's simply not the same. And yet, the message of the Gospel is the same. It has never and will never change. It is the one constant. We have hope because Jesus died and was raised from the dead, conquering sin and defeating death itself – for us!

As we get ready to head into Holy Week and Easter in a way we have never celebrated Holy Week or Easter before, it might be tempting to feel disappointed or even depressed. Now is probably not the time to mention that I bought some new shoes for Easter (and a new dress and new matching outfits for the kids, Chris, and Gabe) that were pretty outlandishly stylish. And yet I'm mentioning it anyway because it's okay to be disappointed, even about what might be considered little things or silly things or frivolous things (not the shoes, obviously, but other silly or frivolous things). At the same time, Holy Week and Easter are actually the best times to remember that we are people who believe in hope because of the resurrection. We are resurrection people! And because of that, we can focus on the good news of the Bible and remember all the stories of light and hope and love that Jesus created and that Jesus inspired. The darkness from Good Friday until Sunday morning was thick and black and seemingly impenetrable. But when that Sunday morning came, the light shone through. With God, the light will always come through.

Let us continue to support one another through whatever trying times we might be experiencing. Call, text, email one another (and if you need a call, text, or email from me, please let me know). Most importantly, let us love one another. Blessings on your Holy Week and on your Easter.


DEI-LY SERVICE

- The rain kept us all in-doors, so we had a lot of close, quality time with the children. We played games and made crafts and were interacting in a very comfortable and relaxed atmosphere.
- Phil Delgado brought a couple of dozen hand-made, custom ceramic bowls (each one unique). Others made a huge batch of warm chili-con-carne. The kids loved the chili on a cold day and they loved their custom made bowls. The kids kept the bowls and probably use them daily. Lunch was served with salad and fruit and chips, cookies and more.
- Stephanie Stoner sent a dozen of her beautiful hand-made, super warm and cute blankets. Each one a unique creation. The kids went nuts over the blankets. And since it was a cold day and the heater at the orphanage was broken (it was super cold inside) the kids were all wrapped up and cuddling with the missionaries on the couch, on the chairs, and on the floor.

We had a near perfect day. Thanks be to God.
