Pastor Sabrina's Dei Light

When An Empty Church is Actually a Good Thing! Under normal circumstances, walking into a nearly empty church on a Sunday is not a good sign. But these are not normal circumstances. Who knows what will happen, but right now, an empty building is a good thing. Here's why I think

1. <u>The church is not the building.</u> The church is the people. One of the things that I have learned from these experiences of following social distancing guidelines is that when the people who are the church cannot meet in a physical building, they will find other ways to worship. Yes, our building is almost empty on Sunday mornings, but I know that prayers and songs continue

to be lifted to God in homes all over the world on Sundays. For Gloria Dei, virtual worship is happening. It's not the same, but it allows us to hear the Word of God, to sing songs, and to allow our children to hear a children's message. Worship continues!

- 2. The church building is empty right now, and that is a good thing because <u>church communities</u> <u>should help set the example for how to follow health guidelines</u>. I shudder when I hear pastors of some churches insist that their congregations will continue to meet because Jesus will protect them or because it is their God-given right to assemble. Yes, we have a right to gather, but why would we do so if it endangers not just us but those around us, our families, neighbors, and those who might be at risk? We are a better church when we protect those in our community.
- 3. Although the church building is empty, <u>the church can be the church because the one thing that hasn't changed in this time of great change is the message of the Gospel</u>. We are the church not because we meet together on Sunday mornings but because we worship God, create a supportive community, and reach out to the world in compassion. The confirmation kids came together but not together at the same time to pack health kits for FAM (Families Assistance Ministry). Every time that I call to check in on someone, they tell me that they have been checking in on others. So I know that ministry continues. I have talked to more people by phone in the past few weeks than probably ever before in a short period of time. And they have been good conversations. People continue to pray for one another, continue to be there for one another, continue to live out the gospel.

I can't wait to be together in person. Until that time, we will continue to be the church wherever we are.

LOS ANGELITOS ORPHANAGE MINISTRY

We had a near perfect day on our recent visit to the orphanage in Tijuana. The fact that it was cold and rainy was actually a great, well timed blessing. The weather was a real blessing for several reasons:

- The rain kept us all in-doors, so we had a lot of close, quality time with the children. We played games and made crafts and were interacting in a very comfortable and relaxed atmosphere.
- Phil Delgado brought a couple of dozen hand-made, custom ceramic bowls (each one unique). Others made a huge batch of warm chili-con-carne. The kids loved the chili on a cold day and they loved their custom made bowls. The kids kept the bowls and probably use them daily. Lunch was served with salad and fruit and chips, cookies and more.
- Stephanie Stoner sent a dozen of her beautiful hand-made, super warm and cute blankets. Each one a unique creation. The kids went nuts over the blankets. And since it was a cold day and the heater at the orphanage was broken (it was super cold inside) the kids were all wrapped up and cuddling with the missionaries on the couch, on the chairs, and on the floor.

CoronaVirus update @ Los Angelitos (March 25, 2020) Everyone is well. No one has contacted the virus. Schools are closed and everyone is hunkering down at home. It is hard for all those children to practice social distancing - they live too close to one another. Pray for them. If one gets sick – they all will.
