

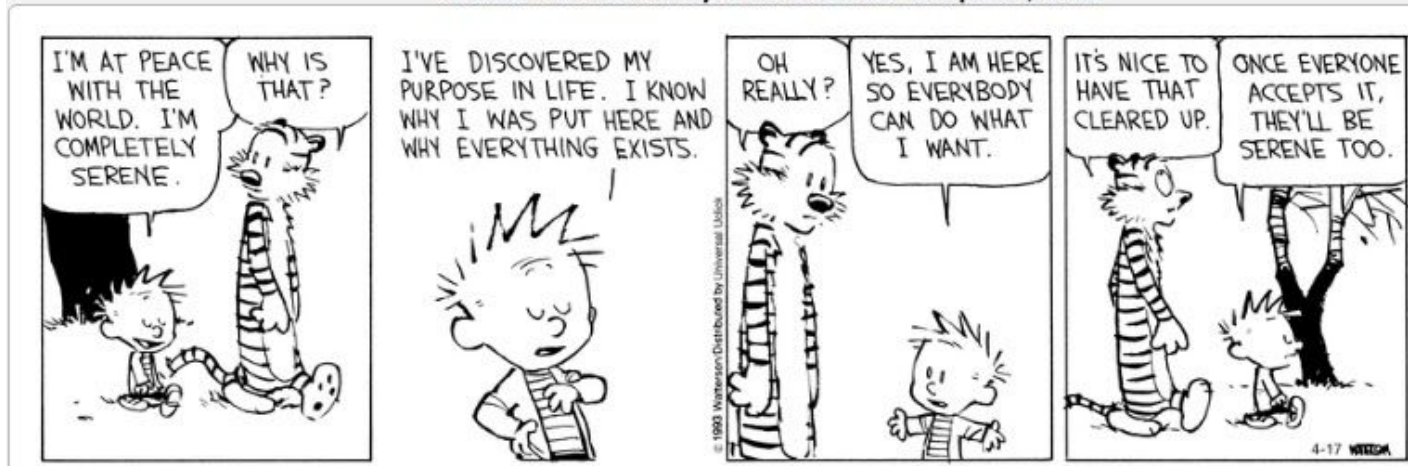
# Confirmation Handout
