ANNUAL MEETING POSTPONED

The Church Council has approved moving the annual meeting to June 27, celebrating in person the ministry that has taken place in 2020 and the first quarter of 2021.



A new budget and new council will be approved. But the main focus will be on celebrating with a luncheon. More details forthcoming as we get closer. FYI - You will be able to pick up an annual report at the Welcome Table or by calling the church office after January 31.

LENT 2021 begins with <u>Ash Wednesday, February 17</u>. At this point, we will have Imposition of Ashes in three ways: 1) <u>Driveby between 8-9am</u>. Pastor David will wait in the parking lot, meet you at your car door for a scripture reading, prayer, confessions, ashes and you're on your way, or, 2) <u>Noon</u> - a brief service in the courtyard (or inside if advisable), 3) The noon service will be <u>livestreamed</u> and you can then watch it at any time.

"REVEALED" Traveling Art Exhibit will be on display for Season of Lent in Bankson Hall (beginning with Ash Wednesday, February 17). *Revealed* features 23 works of various printmaking techniques and covers the entire story of Redemption—from the Fall in Genesis through the New Creation promised in Revelation. The art, along with the Scripture represented, will be our Lenten emphasis.

LATEST FROM CDC (12/30/2020) recommends that people wear masks in public settings, at events and gatherings, and anywhere they will be around other people (especially when singing!). When selecting a mask, there are many choices.



Here are some do's and don'ts. <u>DO</u> choose masks that: Have two or more layers of washable, breathable fabric; Completely cover your nose and mouth; Fit snugly against the sides of your face and don't have gaps



<u>DO NOT</u> choose Masks that: Are made of fabric that makes it hard to breath; Have exhalation valves or vents which allow virus particles to escape; Gaiters & face shields: Wear a gaiter with two layers, or fold it to make two layers; Face Shields alone are not recommended at this time; Find a mask that is made for children to help ensure proper fit.

Check to be sure the mask fits snugly over the nose and mouth and under the chin and there are no gaps around the sides.

CONTINUED SAFETY PRECAUTIONS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC: Please stay home if you are at risk, not feeling well, or for whatever reason cannot follow safety guidelines. Watch the livestream service.

- <u>Face masks are required at worship.</u> Thank you for following the direction of the pastor and Council.
- Bible studies and other gatherings have now gone "virtual." Please contact the church office to join in.
- We will get through this, all of us, together!

It has been challenging for the children to be 'locked- down' inside the orphanage in Tijuana and unable to venture outside except in their small front yard. Some would say stir-crazy, so they have been spending more time than usual at the 'ranch' where the kids can safely run around and play outside.
