


#### MARCH 2021 NEWSLETTER


#### THE BIG THING

(The main thing - put it on your calendar.)

**LENT 2021** focuses on scripture and works of art which illustrate it. Every Wednesday services are being held at noon. The noon service will be <u>livestreamed</u> and you can then watch it at any time.

"REVEALED" Traveling Art Exhibit will be on display for Season of Lent in Bankson Hall. Revealed features 23 works of

various printmaking techniques and covers the entire story of Redemption—from the Fall in Genesis through the New Creation promised in Revelation. The art, along with the Scripture represented, will be our Lenten emphasis.



#### **HOLY WEEK:**

- Palm Sunday with Waving Palms, Processions, and First Communion (March 28);
- Maundy Thursday Individual prayer experience based on the artwork "The Last Supper and the Twelve Tribes" (April 1). Thanks to Jeff Contestabile for creating the Candlelighting station.
- Good Friday Tenebrae Worship (noon and 7pm) The Sanctuary goes slowly darker as we hear the 7 last words of Christ. Your "prayer cards" will be nailed to the cross.
- Easter Resurrection Sunday (April 4, 6:30am-outside; 8:30am, and 10am). Reservations will be taken for Easter for each service so that there's room for everyone. Call the church office to put in your name and number or fill out a form on Sunday morning and place it in an offering box. Registration forms will also be online at mygloriadei.org.

**LATEST FROM CDC** (2/22/2021) recommends that people will need to continue to wear masks even after receiving vaccinations. "It's important for everyone to continue using all the tools available to help stop this pandemic as we learn more about how COVID-19 vaccines work in real-world conditions. Experts are also looking at how many people get vaccinated and how the virus is spreading in communities. We also don't yet know whether getting a COVID-19 vaccine will prevent you from spreading the virus that causes COVID-19 to other people, even if you don't get sick yourself."

Wear masks in public settings, at events and gatherings, and anywhere they will be around other people (especially when singing!).

**IN PERSON HAPPENINGS:** As Gloria Dei opens the sanctuary (25%) and opens up for other in person gatherings, please continue to follow the regular safety guidelines:

- keeping physical distance,
- wearing masks,
- washing hands,
- Staying home if you feel sick, etc.

And, if you cannot follow these guidelines, then please stay home and watch the live-streamed worship and other on-line Bible studies.


