HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY May 30, 2021 (**8:30am, 10:00am**, 5:00pm)

WELCOME to worship! Today is Holy Trinity Sunday. We begin our summer emphasis: "Inside Outside Church." That is, we come together inside to be inspired and to give thanks, but then we go outside to be the church in service to all. A part of this theme will be a different classic prayer connected to scripture. We also will sing parts of a new musical liturgy/chanting. You will learn it quickly! May the Spirit inspire us while inside, in order to go outside to share God's grace with all we meet.

Leader: Speak, O Lord, Your servant is listening. You have the words of eternal life. (People sing Alleluia again.)

The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew the twenty-eighth chapter. **Glory to You, O Lord.** THE GOSPEL: Matthew 28:16-20

Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

THE NICENE CREED

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.
