Last month in worship, I said listening was the most important sharing the faith skill. Today, I'd add another word, kindness.

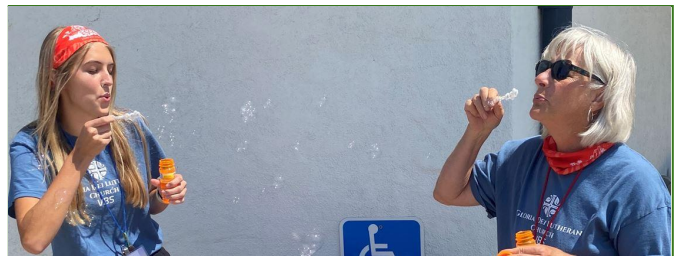

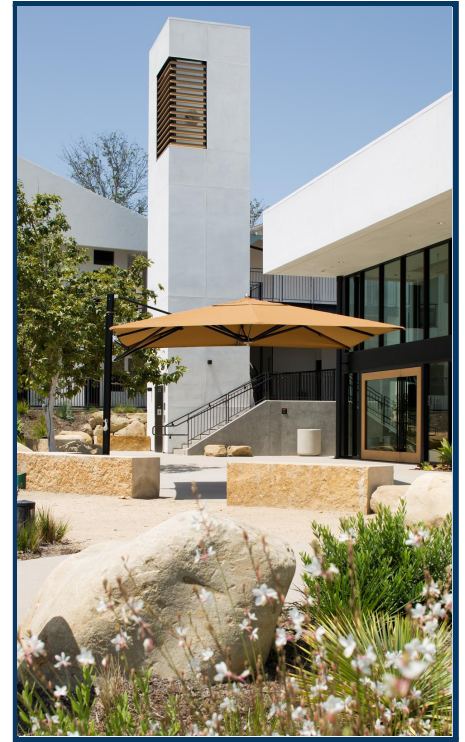


Dear Gloria Dei,

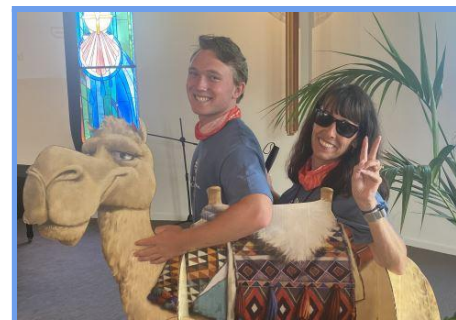
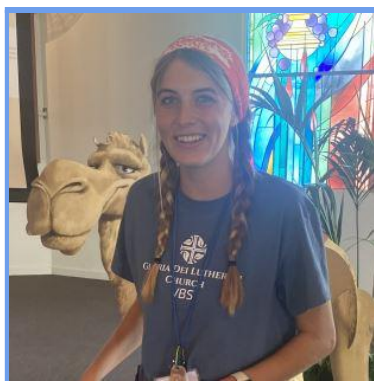
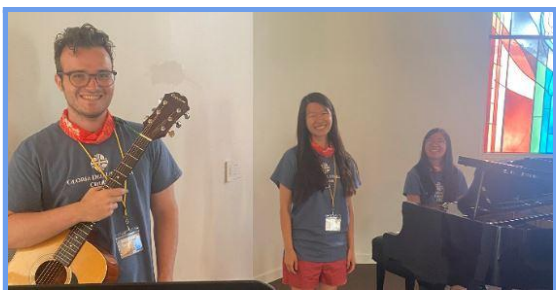
