As I have been settling into a new home, a new workplace, and a new church community, I have been energized by the passion of so many people here at Gloria Dei. Within my first five weeks at Gloria Dei, we have begun the school year at our preschool, welcomed ten new members to our church, launched a new season of Bible study, Confirmation, and Sunday school, held a prayer vigil, and hosted opportunities for growth, fellowship, and community care. I've also had the opportunity to dream up

visions for new ministries in the church alongside church members.

One new ministry that excites me is the ministry of eucharistic visitation. This ministry allows church members to remain connected to the sacramental life of the church through the caring outreach of volunteers. BLESSING OF PETS (Festival of Saint Francis) - On Sunday, October 3 at 5pm, we meet outside the sanctuary for a brief worship time with our furry, scaly & perhaps slimy friends. Bring your dog, cat, goldfish, gecko, etc. to a very brief order of blessing, a "paws" for a prayer.

REFORMATION SUNDAY (Giving of Bible to 3rd graders) - October 31 at the 8:30am & 10am services. It has been a long-held tradition in Lutheran churches to present a Bible to children who are in the 3rd grade. At Gloria Dei, we always present Bibles to our 3rd graders on Reformation Sunday, the last Sunday of October. This has significance for a number of reasons. First, studying Scripture is one of the most important ways we learn about God, and these personalized Bibles with each child's name written in them, is a recognition of that child's growing faith!

Second, the tradition of presenting Bibles to our third grade students is meant to be a gift from the congregation. It is our prayer that this gift will be a starting point for a deeper relationship with God through the study of God's word and the teachings and life of Jesus.

And finally, Reformation Sunday is an appropriate day to celebrate the gift of scripture. Martin Luther's translation of the Bible into German put the Word of God in the hands of the people, so that every person had access to the Bible, including (and perhaps especially) children.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

(Sunday school, Young Children's Events and Ministry)

SUNDAY SCHOOL CHANGE (Age 4 - 5th grade) - Beginning October 3rd and moving forward we will **ONLY have Sunday school at the 10am service**. Our curriculum this year is titled Holy Moly from Augsburg Publishing. Lessons follow a four-part sequence: Discover, Relate, Connect, and Create. Each week, kids watch an animated Bible story video, talk about the story, read their Bible Storybook or Bible, and complete a creative activity.

Sunday school attendees will leave the church service after the children's message for Sunday school instruction and rejoin their families for Communion.

Sunday school is held upstairs in Knudson Hall. Sunday school classes are divided with four year olds - 2nd grade children meeting in one classroom and 3rd-5th graders meeting in the other classroom. All students and teachers will be masked while indoors.

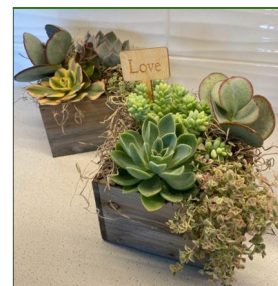
TRICK OR TRUNK - Sunday, October 24th at 5:30pm- 7:00PM

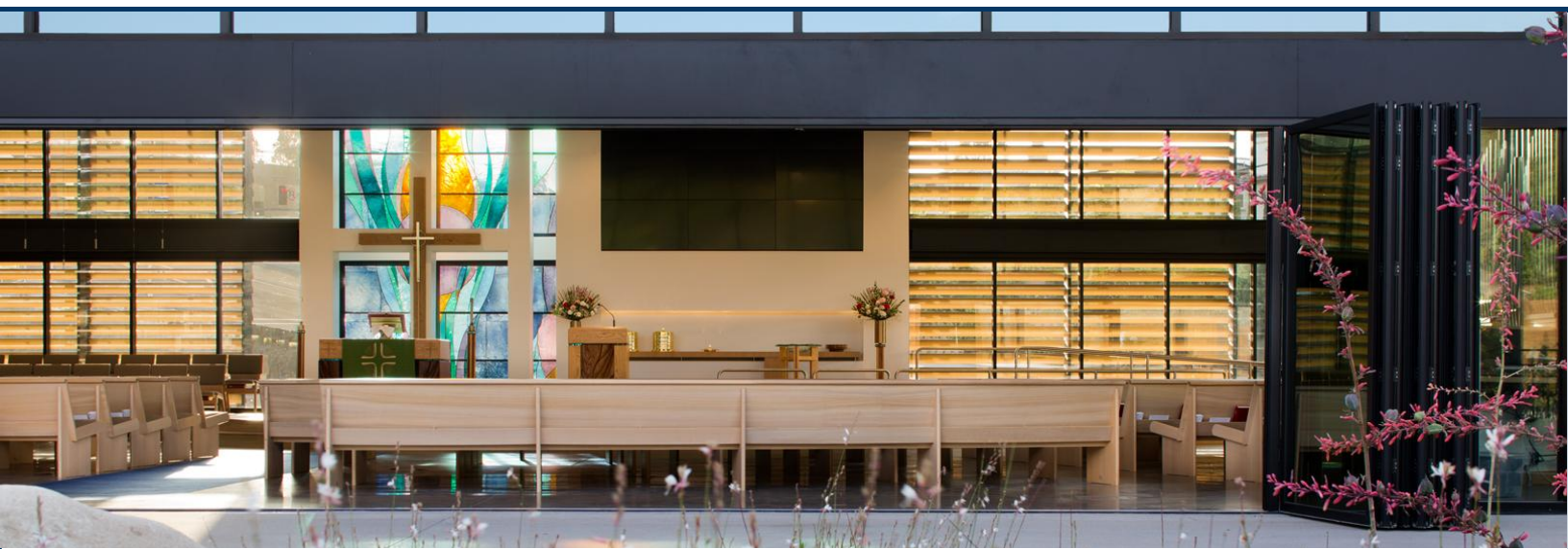

Covid in Tijuana is still at a fever pitch due to its large population (around 2 million people) living in crowded conditions, its poor sanitation, lack of social distance and health care infrastructure.

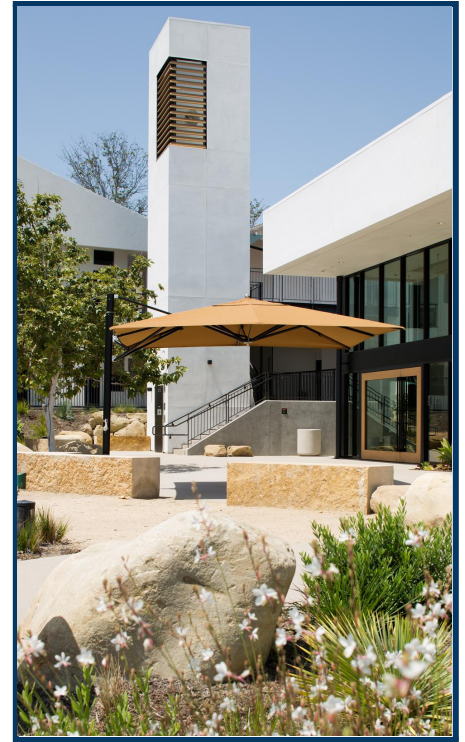
The children are still in 'lock-down' and not allowed any activities outside the home or to participate in group social interactions. All school learning is through State sponsored educational TV programs

or limited zoom-style computer courses. The kids are a bit stir-crazy to say the least, but are remarkably adaptable and making the best of it.

The orphanage has recently taken in 4 additional children: two 5-year-olds, a 6-year-old and a teenager. This was a big commitment because times are very lean, but these kids were in a tough spot and are a real blessing from God.

Ed shared that the financial situation is difficult right now. The orphanage is relying on the monthly gifts from Gloria Dei and on the gifts from some of our members to meet expenses.
