- The story of Joseph is the story of him forgiving his brothers. Define forgiveness.
- What's hard about forgiveness?
- In what ways is his story like the story of Jesus?

FROM THE LESSON:

Overview of Genesis 37-50 and retell Joseph and his brothers' story.

What was it about Joseph that helped him to keep going, even

after so many terrible things happened to him?

Joseph had some important skills (For one, he could interpret dreams.) that he used to help others. Think about your skills, abilities, talents, likes - could you see yourself using them to help others? How so?

The story of Joseph tells us how the family of Abraham and Sarah (the Jewish people) end up in Egypt. What do you think will be the challenges of living there for them?
