Dear Gloria Dei family,

As you know, Easter is a Season in the church and more, every Sunday is a celebration of the resurrection. To that end, we'll be using a synod wide resource after Easter - **Sharing Our Faith Stories**. Every congregation in the Pacifica Synod of the ELCA will be encouraged to participate.

What is it? Basically it's a Bible study on Evangelism. For some, the word "evangelism" has negative connotations, evoking handing out pamphlets or people judging people - who's in and who's definitely out.

Instead, this study is meant to "open biblically-based conversations about how to be relational, flexible, and respectful." It looks at some famous Bible stories and has us thinking about our own faith stories.

At Gloria Dei, we'll be using this as a Sermon Series (with a take home page available for further discussion), various Bible studies (GIFT Group, Heart-Lifters, Women's Bible Study, Men's Breakfast) will all be encouraged to participate, plus you can simply do it on your own, or as a couple, or as a family.

My faith story began as a child. My parents prayed and worshiped regularly. I saw them care for people in desperate situations (Mrs. Johnson, a not-so recovering alcoholic stayed in our guest room often), and they always pointed to Jesus' grace and mercy. I knew their faith was real and important, so it launched my own story of personal discovery.

What about you? Who or what are the details of your following the Risen One?

In my first week of seminary, I encountered these words while reading *Confessions* by Saint Augustine of Hippo. This was the first of many "Aha!" moments in my seminary journey. It changed my perspective on evangelism forever.

I realized the only reason I knew God, the only reason I had learned to pray or worship or proclaim was that someone else had taught me first. Someone else had taken the first step to share the love of Jesus in words and actions, to make God's love real for me. Actually, there were a lot of "someone else's". Pastors and teachers and family and friends, VBS volunteers, choir directors, a man at a homeless shelter, a stranger who prayed for me at confirmation camp. And so many other people I can never thank enough for giving me the joy and strength of my faith.

And then I got to thinking, who am I to say that I am not able to do the same? Who am I to say that God wouldn't work through me, to bless others as I have been blessed? I suddenly felt free to share my faith with friends, not with an agenda, but because it is something true about me. I felt free to pray with and for people, because I had been blessed by others who did the same for me.

(All things related to service, ministry, helping others, compassion, caring, loving, serving "the least of these", etc.)


