
Confirmation Handout

INTRODUCTIONS IN SMALL GROUP: Tell us your name and the "hardest" thing you've ever done.

HIGHS AND LOWS - Share one positive thing and one negative thing that happened this week.



CHOOSE QUESTIONS from the following to feed the discussion on the topic:

- At the beginning of the story of all the kings of Israel, a prophet always anoints the king and sometimes even "fires" them. Why is it important to have someone as a check on the power of a king?
- . Do you remember or know any stories about David, as a shepherd or as a king?
- Many of the Psalms, the Songs of the Jewish people were either written for King David or commissioned by him, or even written by him. What's a favorite song for you? How about a favorite song/hymn we sing at church?

FROM THE LESSON:

- Go over and talk about some of the highlights and lowlights of David as king.
- Samuel was a prophet who anointed Saul and then took the crown away. What is a prophet?
- Read some Psalms: Psalm 1, 23, 100.
- Go over the 10 Commandments and see how many you know by heart.
