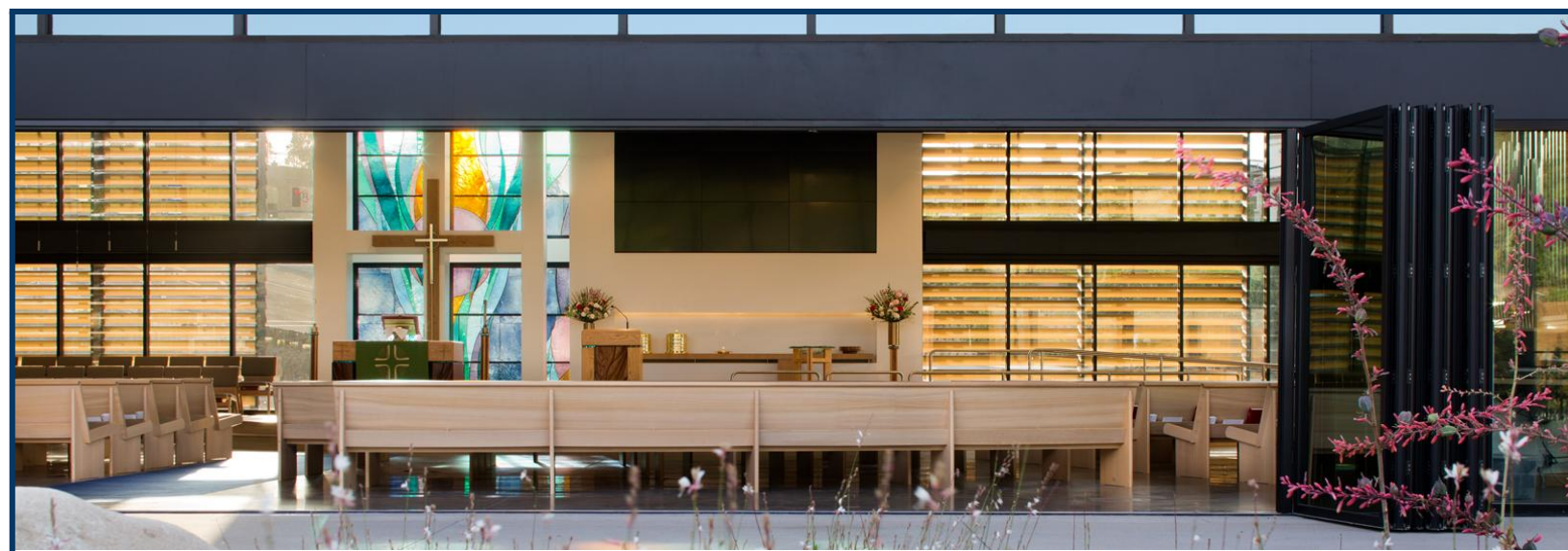


PRESCHOOL

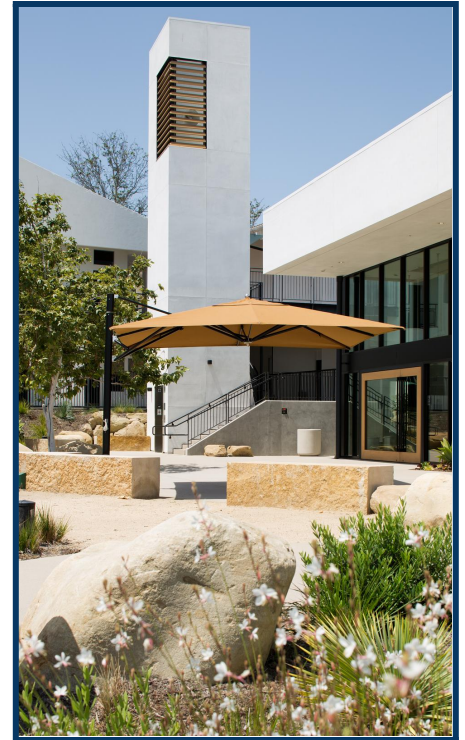

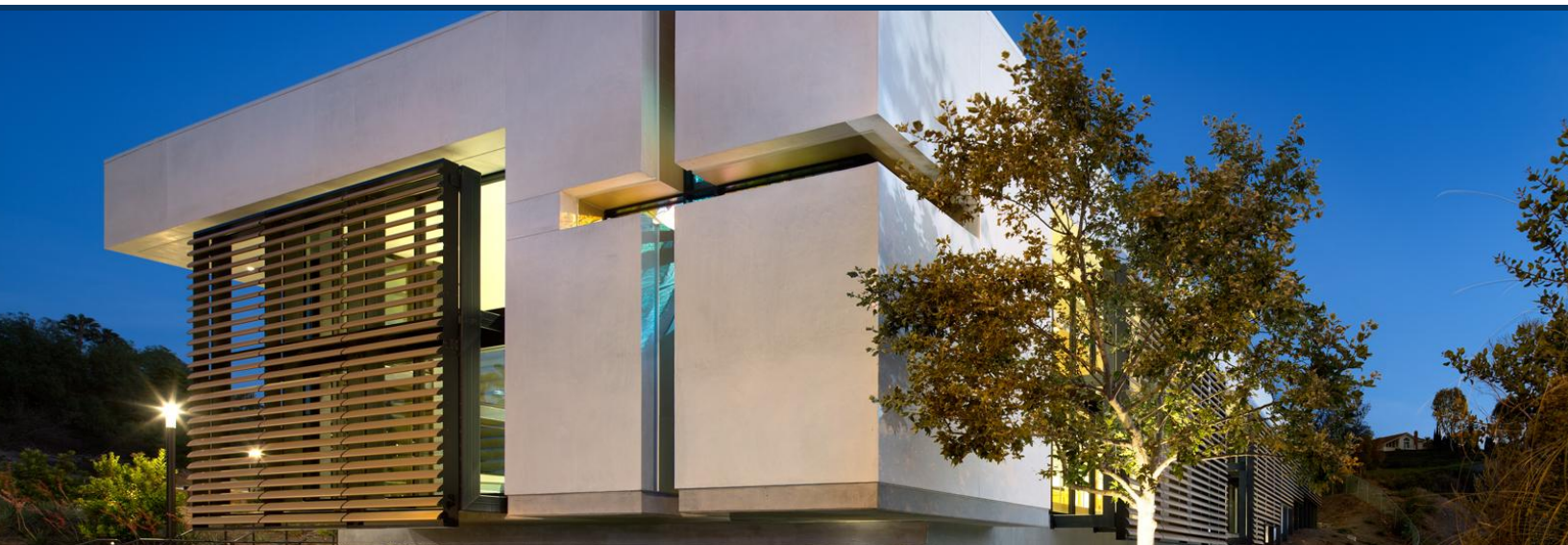
