

Dear Gloria Dei family,

One Sunday a year, we ask people to think about what they will do in the coming year, in terms of their time, talent, and treasure. We ask people to fill out two forms, a pledge card and a Time and Talent sheet. This year, October 16, is our **ThanksLiving** Sunday. Please pray about how you can support the ministry of Gloria Dei. And as you're thinking about time, talent, and treasure, ask this question: **What's in my hand?**

In Exodus 3, Moses encounters God in a burning bush. God asks Moses to do the impossible, to free His people from slavery. Moses has many excuses, such as, 'It's impossible,' or 'I can't speak well,' or 'Send someone else.'

And then God asks Moses, "What's in your hand?" What was in his hand was a simple, gnarled wooden staff, not a royal scepter. If you remember Moses' story, he miraculously became the adopted son of Pharaoh's daughter. But then, from a position of privilege, he now found himself in a foreign land, with few resources, and a tenuous future. What's in your hand? **The shepherd's staff represented all that he had lost.** But God was with him.

Instead of wishing life had turned out differently, God uses our very real lives, especially the struggles. And with Moses, and with us, it is enough.

What's in your hand? That's the question for Stewardship Sunday. How has God blessed you? Certainly your life hasn't turned out like you thought, but that's ok. God is with you.

What's in your hand? Sometimes God uses our failures to prepare us for ministry, to make us more compassionate, and to fully trust in the One whose grace is enough. God used Moses' reluctant willingness, God used what was in Moses' hand, an old staff, to accomplish the impossible. What's in your hand?
