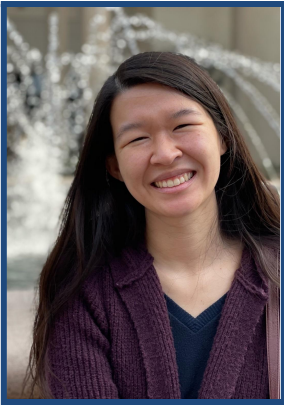

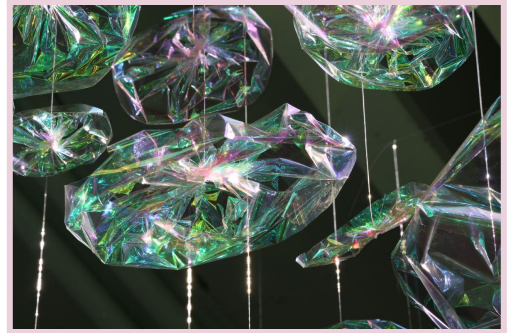
MICHELLE LUM, Minister of Arts and Outreach

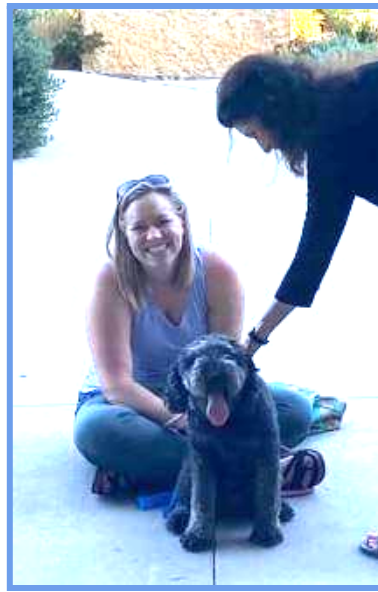
God is great and uses us for good; spread joy, kindness, and love this Thanksgiving season.

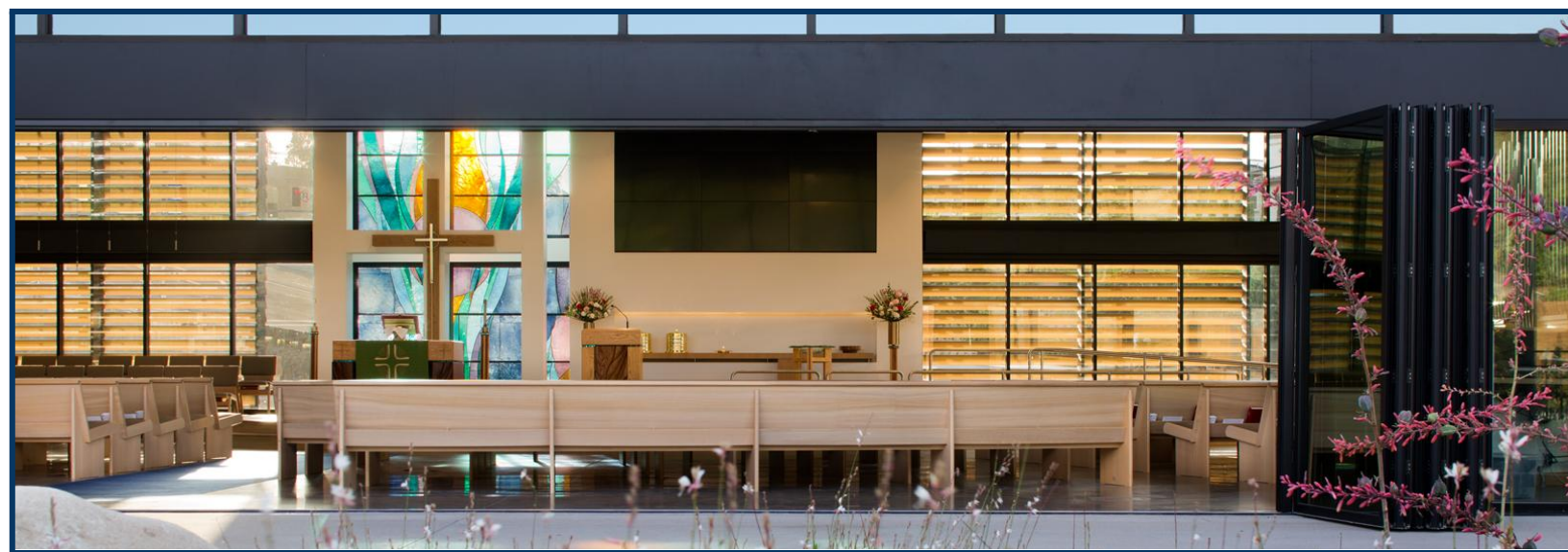

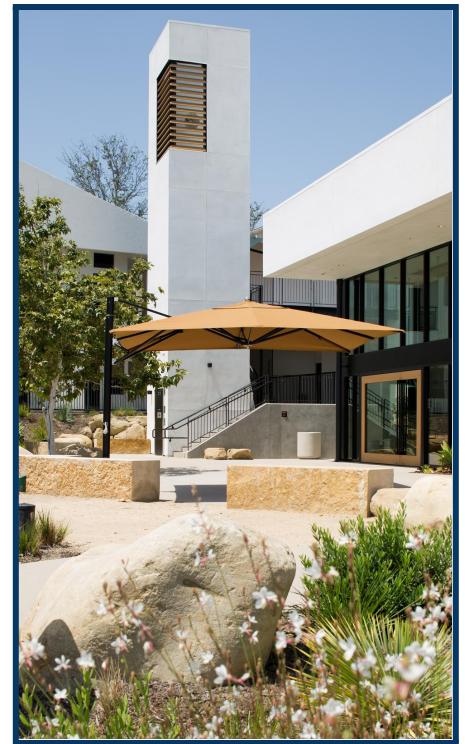
