South Coast Literacy Council English Second Language Group introduced Ukrainian School of Orange County to Gloria Dei...

Ukrainian School of Orange County has been meeting at Gloria Dei since October 2022. Previously, the group was meeting at a different site, but had been asked to find another place to meet. Nataliya K., grandparent refugee from Ukraine, came to our South Coast Literacy Council ESI class; she began working hard to learn English. A couple of weeks later her daughter, Maria, asked to speak to someone regarding the possibility of hosting a Saturday school for refugee Ukrainian children. Maria was welcomed and Ukrainian School of Orange became a reality at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church.

The school has grown. There are now fourteen students ages 6-11. Students and teachers are delighted to be able to work and play in such a bright, happy environment. Students love being able to meet other children who are also refugees, who share the same first language, and understand their shared culture and traditions. They giggle and laugh with joy as they play with their new friends.

The initial students were refugees from Ukraine living with American families. As our Ukrainian population grew, so did the school. (The Ukranians in Orange County Facebook group has grown from 600 members to 2,500.) Nataliya was the first teacher; now there are three: a single refugee mom who teaches language, another refugee mom/art teacher, and a refugee professor of history who teaches history and culture. An additional six to eight middle school students meet at Dana Point Senior Center.

The school continues to flourish. Laura, a SCLC tutor arranged a \$500 donation from her church, St. Clement's Episcopal Church in San Clemente, as part of their outreach program. As Maria, the director shared, "There are no words to describe how happy and grateful parents, kids and teachers are as now as they are able to meet at Gloria Dei Church to study and play every Saturday in a beautiful and safe place!"
