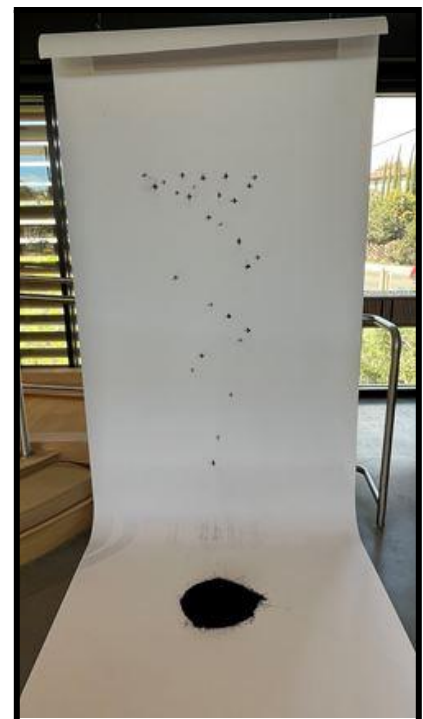
ART MINISTRY - You are Dust

You are Dust

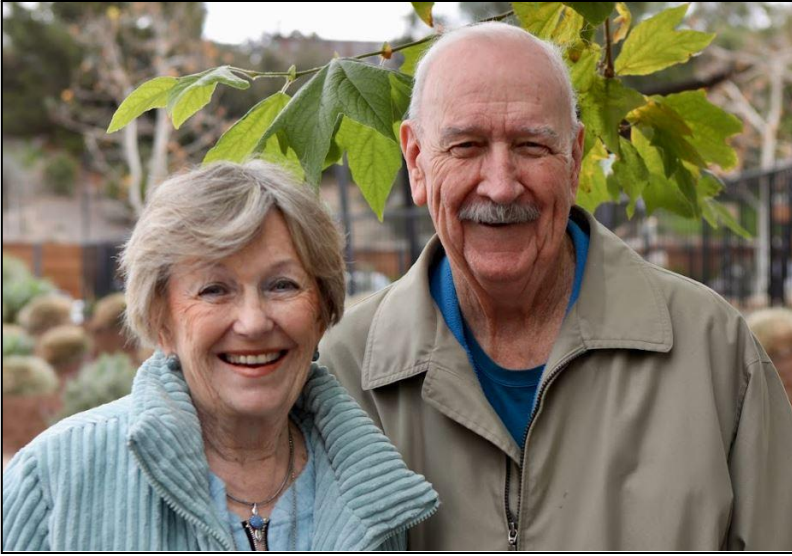
Paper, charcoal, foil

This piece is inspired by my experience of Ash Wednesday here at Gloria Dei. One phrase that is often said in the imposition of the ashes is: "Remember you are dust, and to dust you will return." I wanted to make a work that helped me understand that better. What does it mean to be dust? How do you convey your own mortality? This piece is my response to those questions. The pile of "dust" is the amount of ash I would be if you were to turn me to dust today. The marks of the cross correspond to my age, each of them specifically placed at the height I was each year in my life.

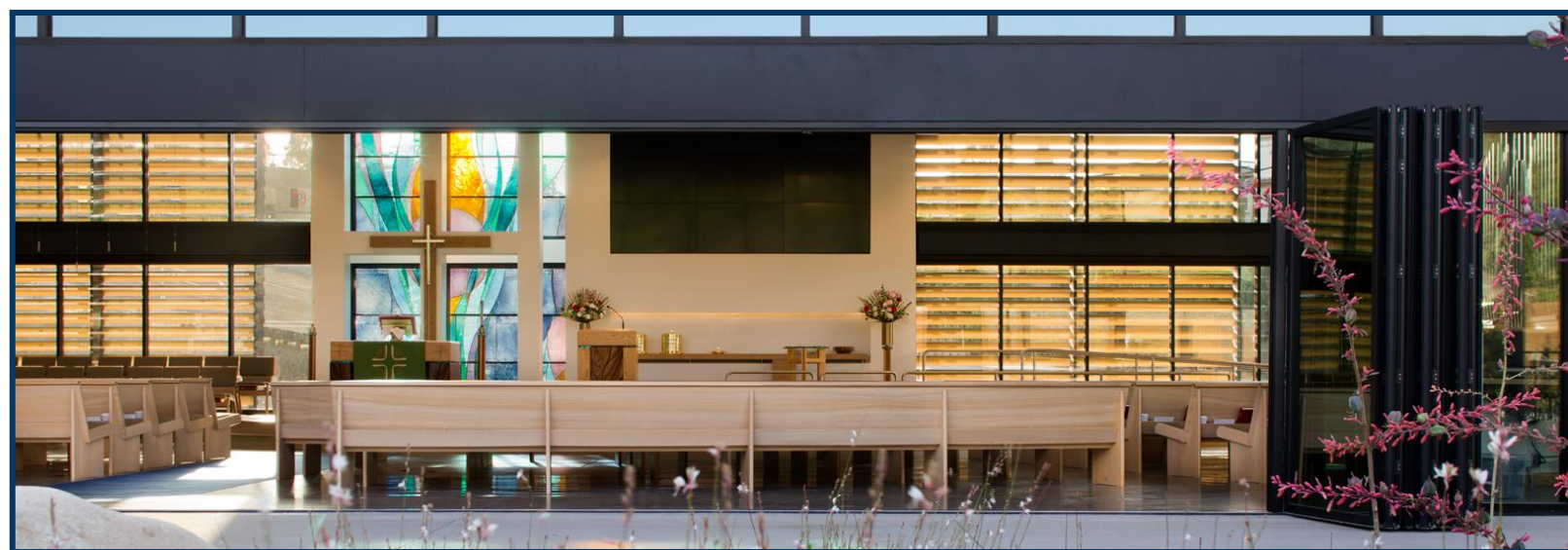

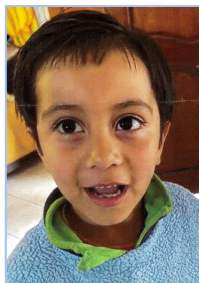

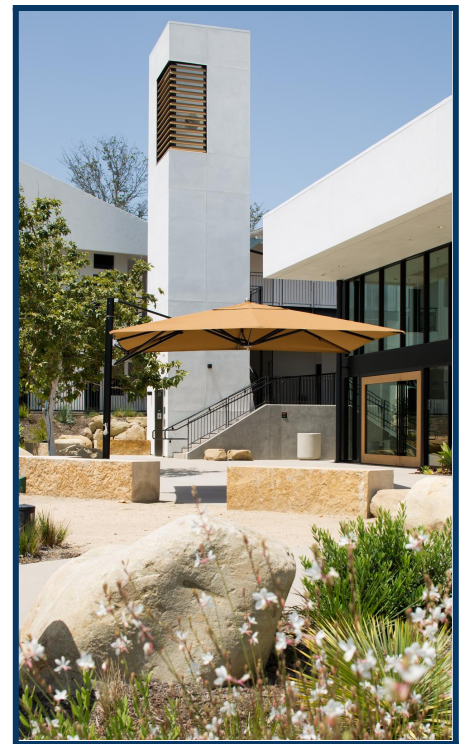
A LETTER FROM THE DIRECTORS:
