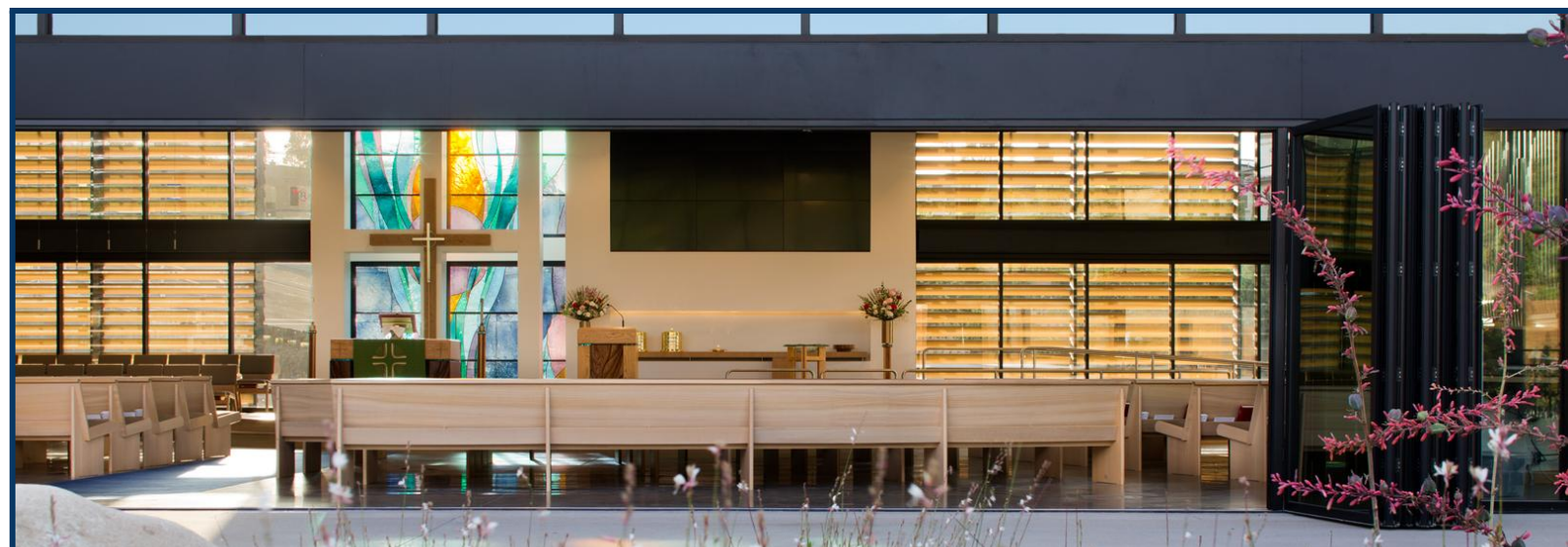
Thank you for your prayers and support. My prayer for all of you is to always put God first and to ask him how you can serve him more.
