CHILDREN'S MINISTRY (Young Children's Ministry)



LOS ANGELITOS ORPHANAGE MINISTRY - Good news to report to all of you from Gloria Dei, who so graciously and generously donated to purchase the big passenger van for Los Angelitos Orphanage. The van



is in great shape and is well maintained and parked in a secure area at the orphanage behind locked gates. The van is used every day to safely take children to school. It is also used every Sunday to transport the children to church, and frequently used for doctors and dentist appointments, for field trips and more.

Another update is the recent installation of a water tank. The roof-mounted water tank is essential because electric service is inconsistent, and when the power is 'out', the water pump can't deliver water to the orphanage. The new water tank uses gravity to deliver water whenever needed for cooking, cleaning and bathing.
