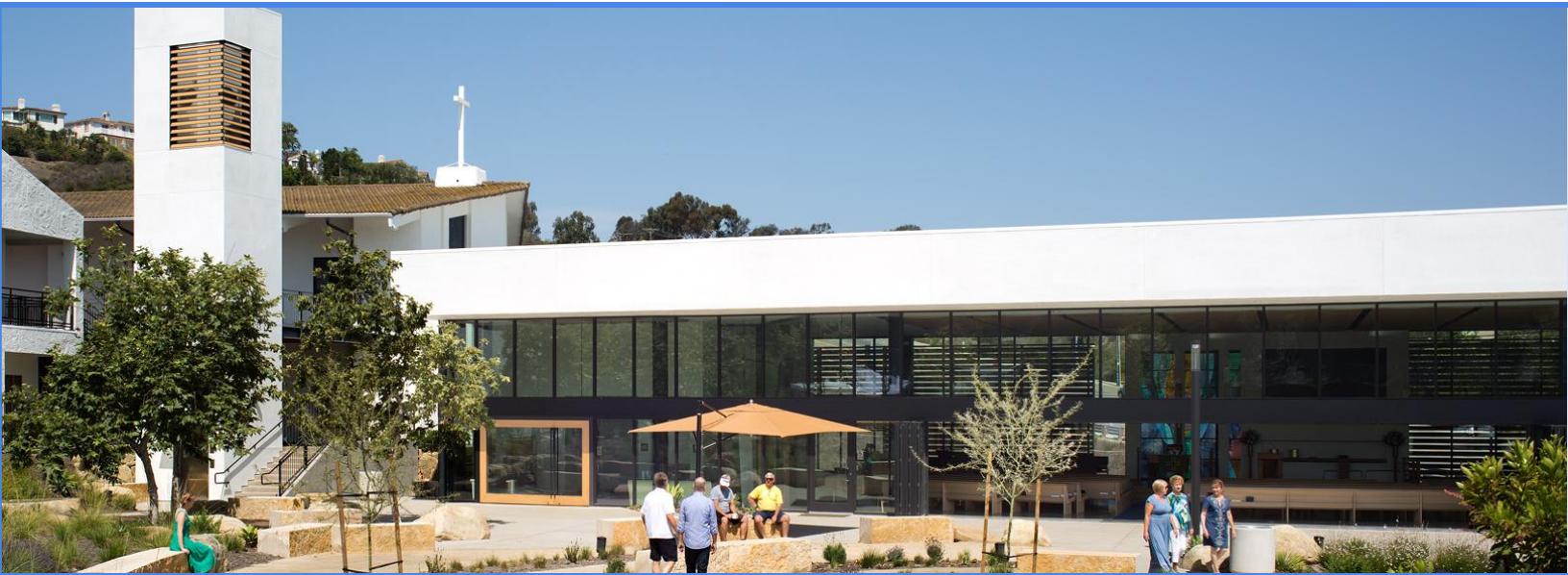

Busy-ness can be a good thing or simply a tiring thing. A few deep breaths, a pause for prayer, a walk outside, meeting up with a friend... all these sorts of happenings help. Here are a few ideas to catch your breath, following the example of an ancient group - The Desert Mothers and Fathers.

- Select a verse that can be said as a prayer in one breath. (*Example: Lord have mercy.*)
- Sit comfortably. Close your eyes.
- Think of the inhale, as breathing in God's Spirit. On the exhale think of surrendering and expelling anything that puts distance between you and God.
- Open your hands and place them palms up on your lap, representing an openness to God.

Like a good cup of coffee with a friend, like watching the sun set over the ocean, like listening to Fred Johnson play the piano, this breath prayer is something which will help us catch our breath.

Halloween is coming up and all the scary decorations are out in the stores now. I don't think of myself as an especially fearful person, but it struck me that even though I've long outgrown my fear of scary costumes, there are still things I am afraid of. I'm afraid of not meeting deadlines, of disappointing others, of not saying the right things and missing opportunities. Whether you have the same fears—or other ones—God has a lot of encouragement for us in his Word. Here's one from Isaiah 41:10: *"Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God; I will strengthen you; I will help you; I will uphold you with my victorious right hand."*

We might not face physical persecution like those in the Bible (or even those in other countries), but these words can still be a comfort for us. When God says do not fear, he's not just talking about physical dangers. He's talking about all the things that concern us, the expectations and worries that take our attention away from God. God is for us and he will be with us. Don't let fear turn your attention away from what truly matters! A question for you, if you'd like to think further on this: where is there still fear in your life, and how can you give it to God?

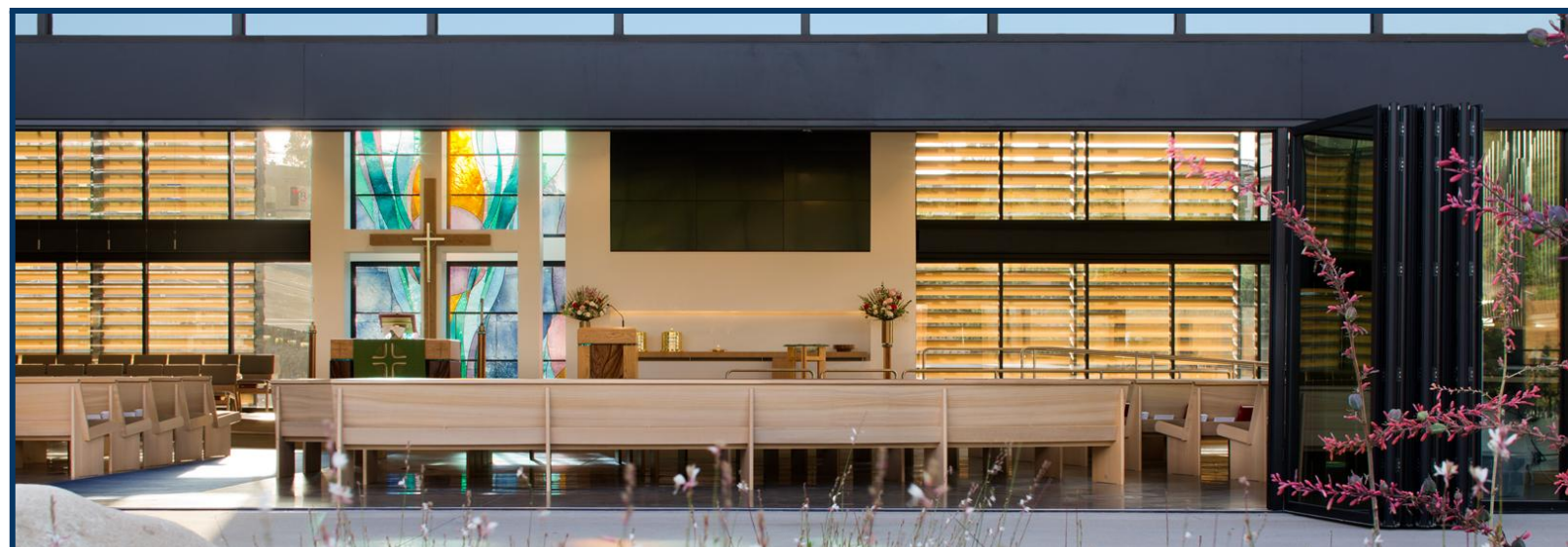

- Everyone had a wonderful and enjoyable time: the kids are so much fun and they love it when we visit. When we arrive, all the kids come running and calling in excitement.

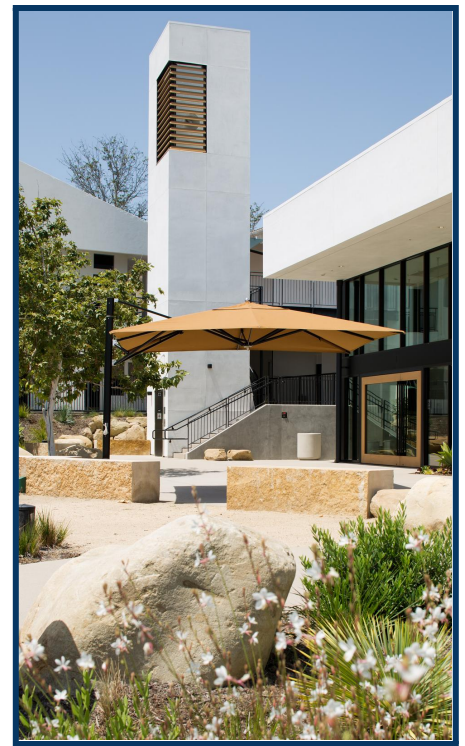
- There are currently 23 children living in Los Angelitos. They range in age from 3 to 17 years old. And yes if you are wondering, it is perfectly safe

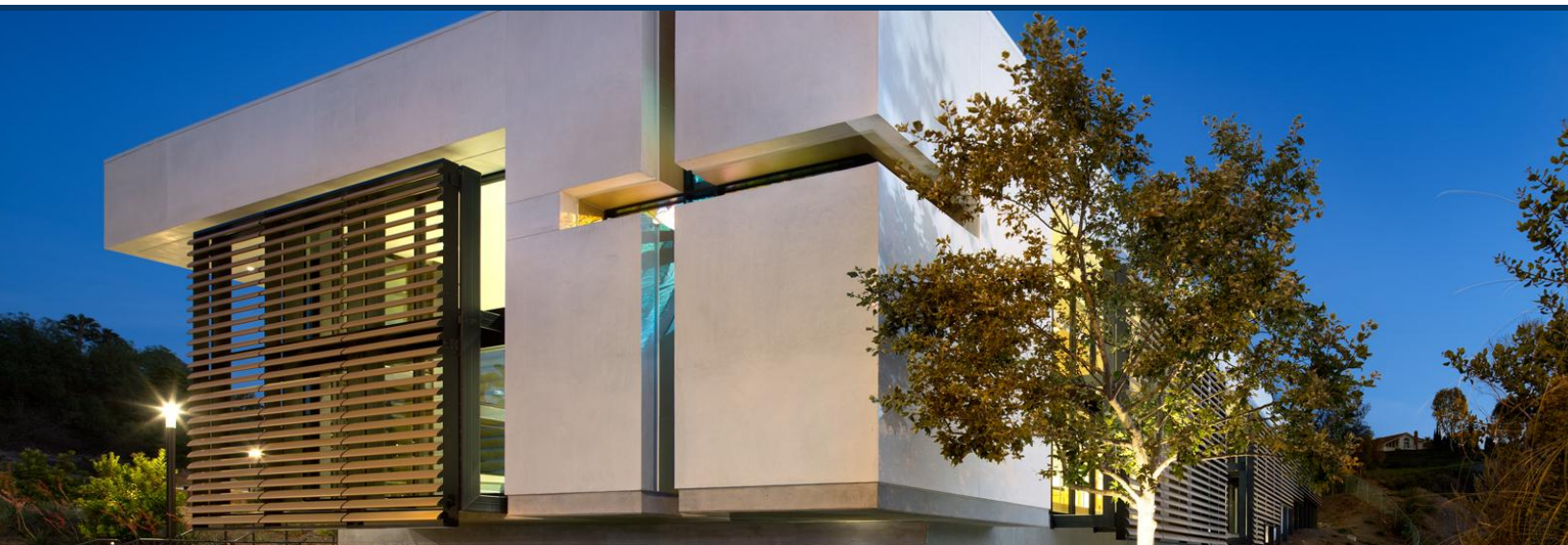
traveling across the border and spending the day in Mexico. It is not only safe, it is a lot of fun and very rewarding!
