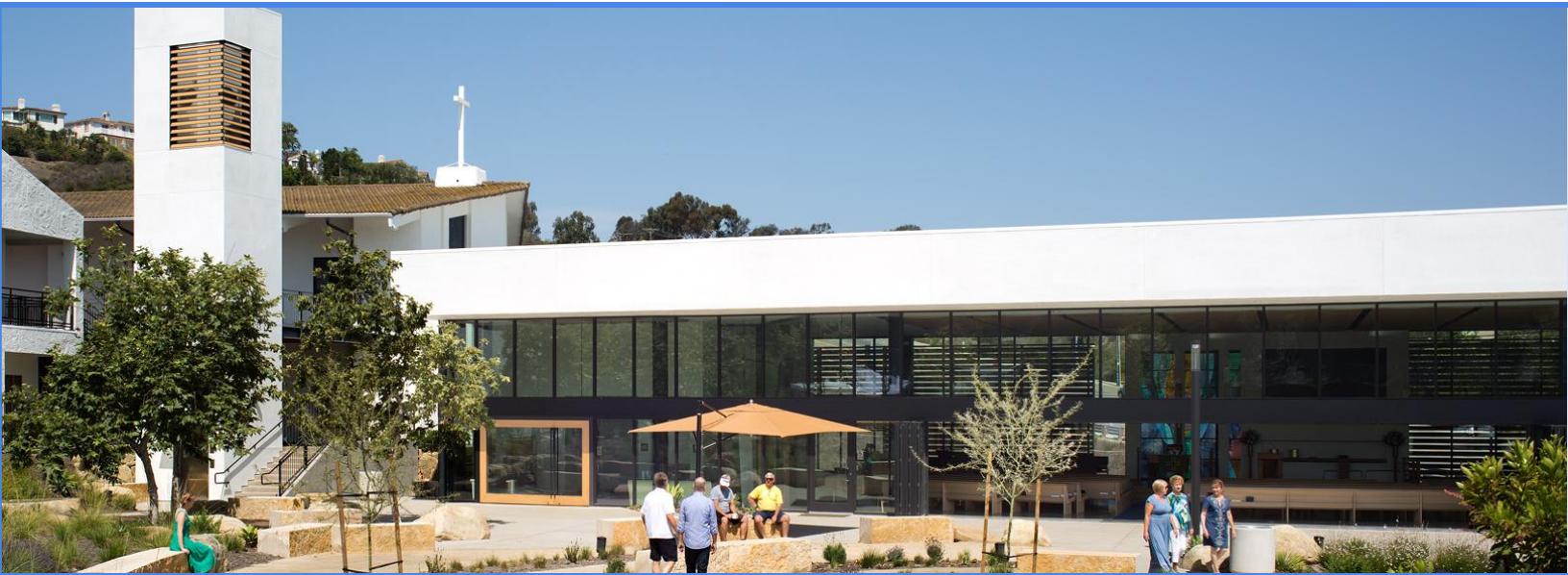

Dear Gloria Dei family,

There will also be the traditional preparations - Advent wreath and candles, carols sung, Christmas tree decorations with "Christmons," caroling, cookie exchanges, and more. Thanks to all the people helping make this Advent Season so hopeful, through your prayers, small kindnesses, volunteering, and singing. Your actions proclaim the words of the carol we will sing all four Sundays - *O Come, O Come, Emmanuel*:

Preschool will be on a well-deserved Christmas break from December 22, 2023 through January 7, 2024. Merry Christmas & Happy New Year!

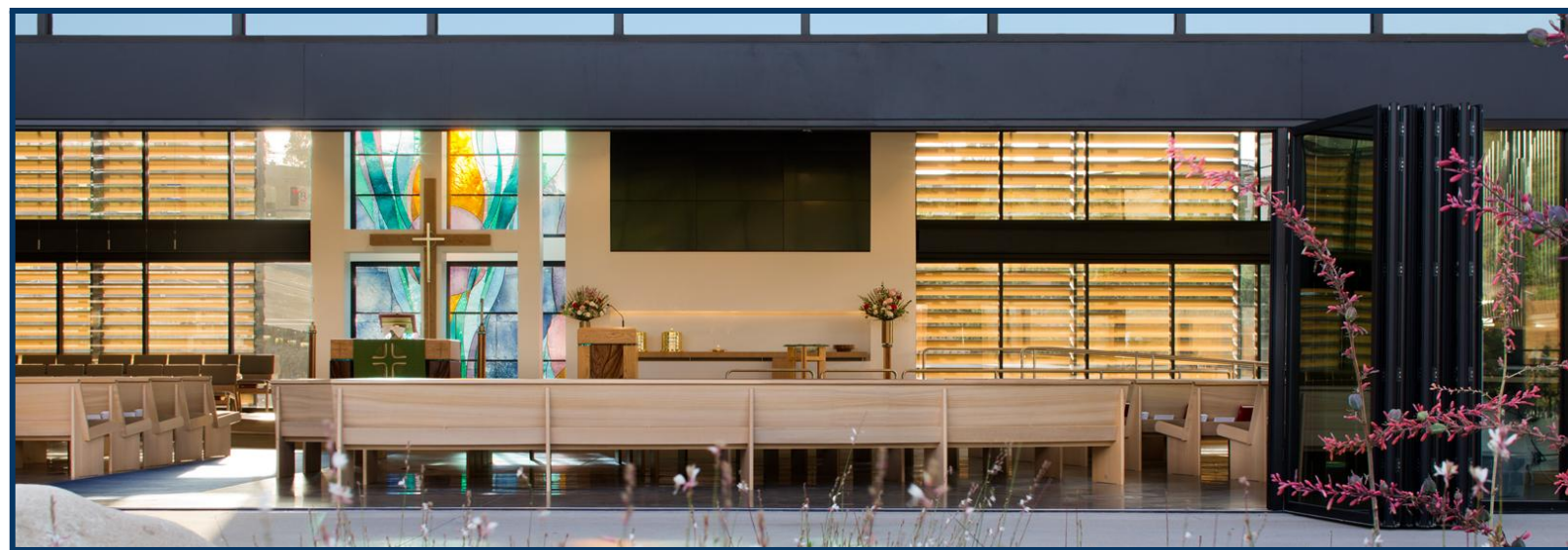

LOS ANGELITOS ORPHANAGE MINISTRY



The orphanage has increased staff up to eight people, which includes full-time and part-time employees. More staff results in increased attention for the children, but less attention toward maintenance and facility improvements due to budgetary constraints.

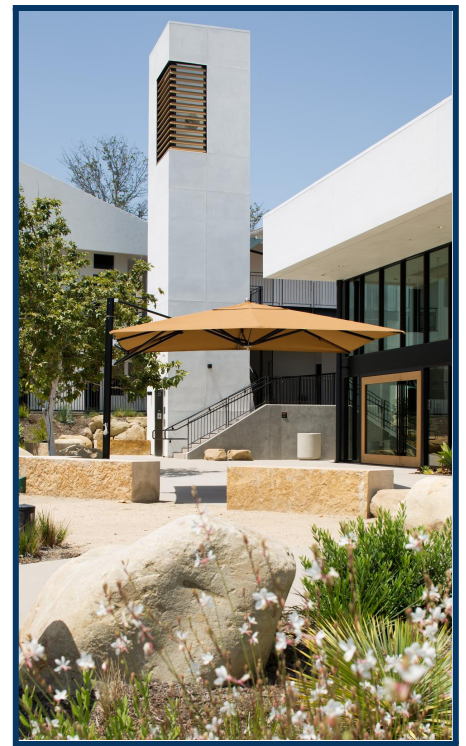
The van that Gloria Dei donated to Los Angelitos is a God-send and it is used every day. It is well maintained and in excellent shape. When not in use, it is parked behind a locked gate on the orphanage property.

There are currently 22 children living in the orphanage, down slightly from 25. One child aged-out, another moved to another facility and Bianca graduated high school and has moved on to college!

We are planning another visit in early 2024 and will announce a date soon. We hope you join us, so you too can see how rewarding it is to help those in need at Los Angelitos. They are so appreciative & grateful.
