Have you heard of the 10,000 hour rule? They say you can master any skill if you work at it for 10,000 hours. Some ideas to get the juices running: pick a scripture to read everyday, schedule a time to pray daily, memorize a few verses, or join a Bible study. I pray that this Lenten season you find yourself even closer to God than before. And as my professors say: get to work!

great time to join!





LOS ANGELITOS ORPHANAGE MINISTRY - Many people ask themselves; "Shall I join a Los Angelitos trip?" While others may ask: "I can't go, but I want to support the Orphanage – how do I help?"

Joining a mission trip is fun and rewarding and provides an opportunity to learn about the orphanage. Yet while the children enjoy our company, it is the missionaries that are most blessed. It is we missionaries that really benefit the most from our visits, not the children.

So then, if I can't go, or even if I do go, how do I best help these orphans?

- 1. **PRAY** Pray for the children. Pray for their caregivers, pray for the orphan, and pray for those individuals and organizations that support the orphanage.
- 2. **GIVE FINANCIALLY** It is really expensive to raise 20 or 30 kids. A portion your offerings at Gloria goes toward Los Angelitos, and it helps. But they need much more. You can also give directly to Los Angelitos.
- 3. **SHARE the GOSPEL** All believers are called to share the gospel with non-Christians around us. In doing so, we join the work of missionaries around the world in reaching others for Christ. Tell your neighbors, friends, work colleagues and others about our work with Los Angelitos. It is a great way to share your faith with others.
- 4. **SUPPORT Los Angelitos Trips** You can support our trips donating food, laundry soap, personal care items and more. Needs vary by trip so just ask. Other ways to support is by picking up the rental van and other chores.


