

Dear Gloria Dei family,

March will be <u>historic</u> at Gloria Dei and in my opinion, beautiful. Here are a few happenings of note:

Daneen Pysz, who currently heads up our Eucharistic Visitation Ministry with Dana Becker has finished all her coursework related to becoming a Deacon in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. After approval, she will need to be ordained as a servant in "Word and Service" and that will be coordinated with Bishop Dave Nagler.

What's historic about this? Gloria Dei has never had a Deacon and this is a wonderful opportunity. For those who know Daneen, she is creative, passionate, kind, and faithful. Please join us for this important meeting and watch for more details related to her job description.

She will help us communicate powerfully - Grace changes everything!




