Dear Gloria Dei family,

Years ago, I studied ELCA churches across the country that had amazing growth in worship attendance and were located in zip codes of decline. One church, still the largest ELCA congregation, worships around 26,000/Sunday. One church was hard to find, down dirty roads, a country church and had grown from 20 people in worship to 120. One Hispanic ministry grew from 100 in worship to 500 in a few years. All the churches and pastors were very generous with their time.

What did they have in common? At first glance, not much. Some were contemporary, some were traditional in style. Some had praise bands, some had a pipe organ. Some were strictly liturgical, others changed it up each Sunday. But despite their differences, I came away with a few convictions:

- 1) The "style" of worship or music is secondary, as long as it's done well.
- 2) Preaching is critical. People have less time to make a connection, so the message time is vital.
- 3) Mission - Each church had their mission statements, tag lines plastered everywhere. That's why we came up with "*Grace changes everything!*" In the end, the variety of programs all flowed from a powerful witness to the cross.
- 4) Evangelism/Outreach Programs - Each congregation had an intentional way of encouraging members to invite friends to worship. From this flowed my idea of the 4dm - *The Fourth Day Movement*.

We just celebrated Easter and each Sunday we proclaim in our creeds - "*On the third day, He rose from the dead.*" The Fourth Day Movement (4dm) is our response to Easter - sharing the world's greatest hope.

Will you pray about that this Easter Season? Is there someone you can invite to worship? Is there someone you know who needs crucified love? Is there someone who needs grace? They may thank you for life!

Prayers through this process are much appreciated.

I am so grateful for this opportunity to have served here at Gloria Dei! It has been an incredible learning experience and a joy to spend time with you all. In the next few weeks I will be emotionally reflecting on the last two years as I look toward this time of transition. Thank you for everything!

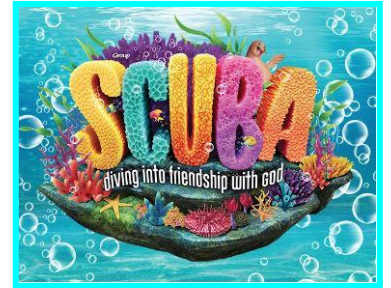

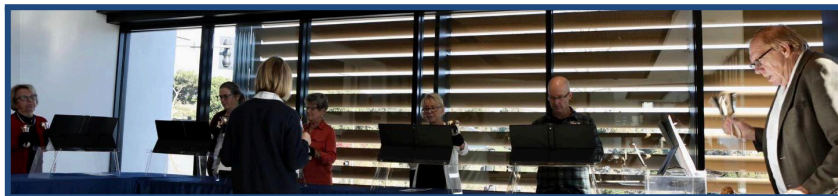


DEI-LY WORSHIP

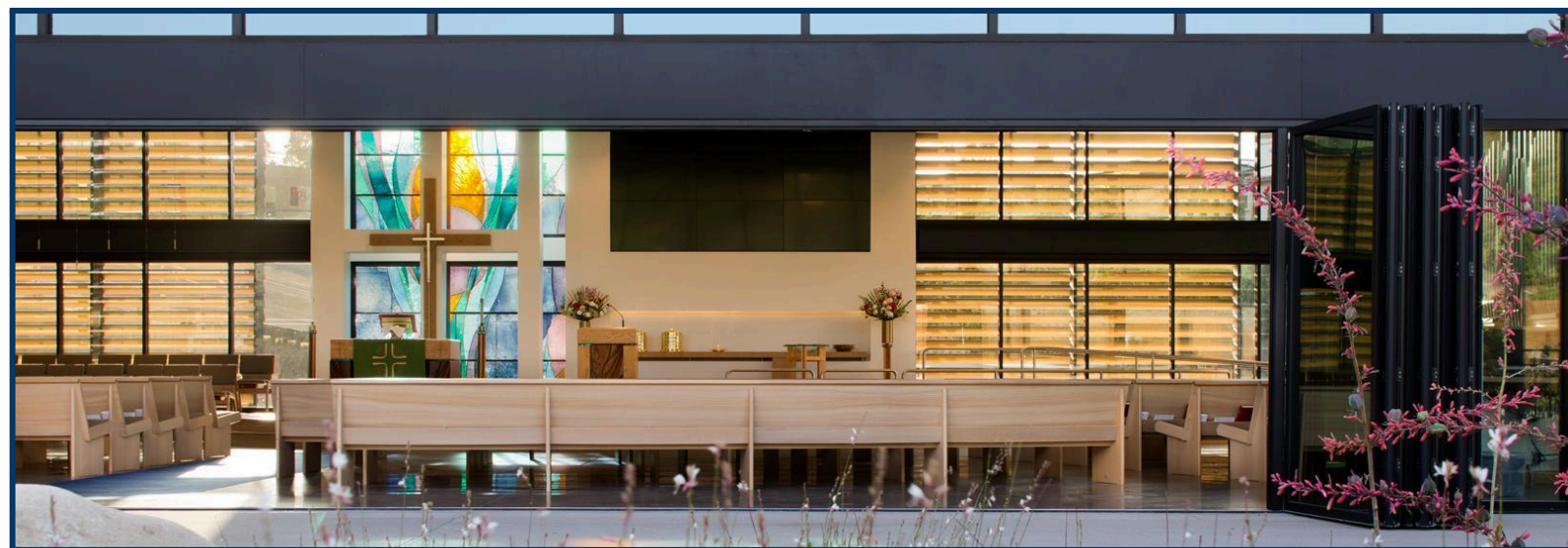

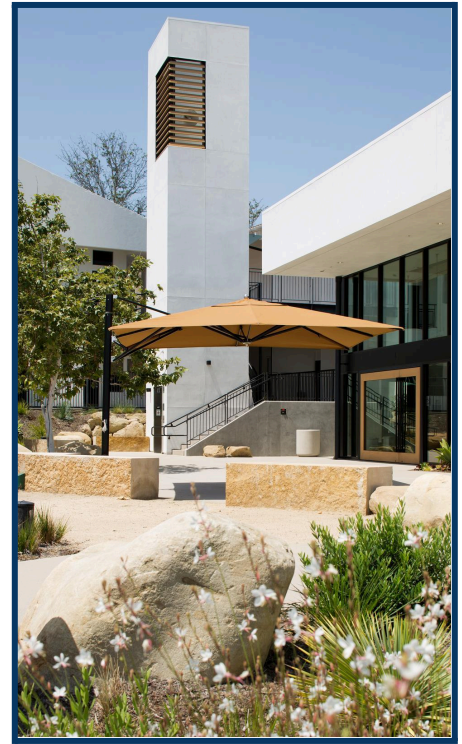
