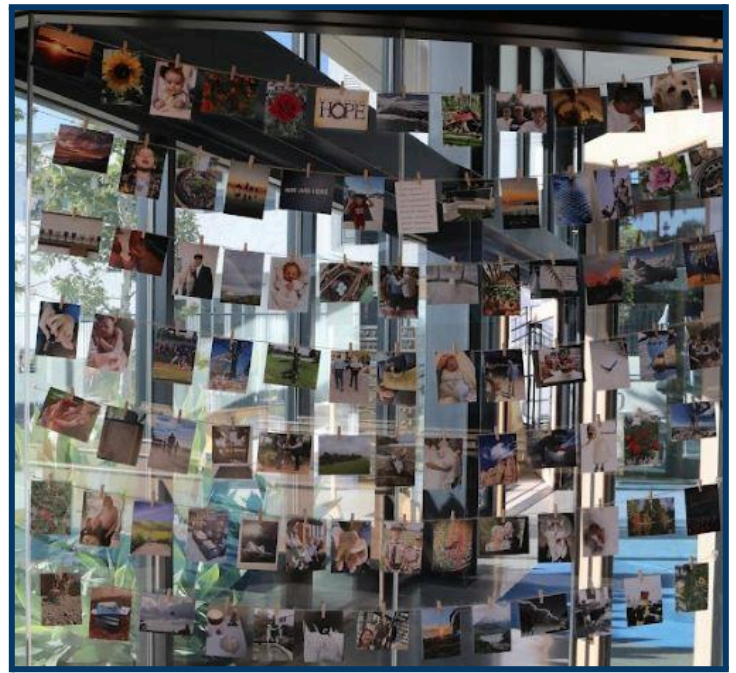

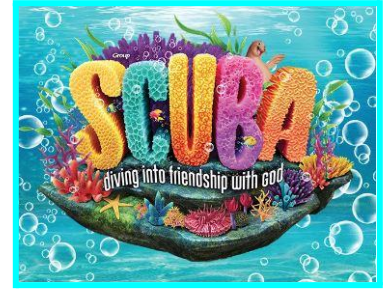
DAD'S ROOTBEER FLOATS - June 16 between services. Servers will be whipping up some delicious floats for our Dads and everyone else!

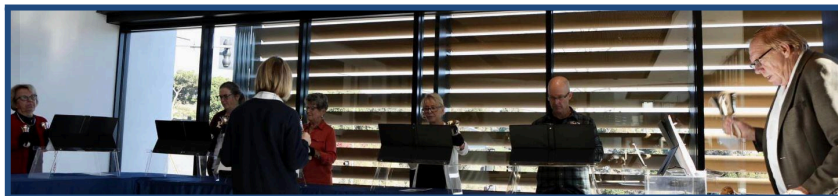


DEI-LY WORSHIP

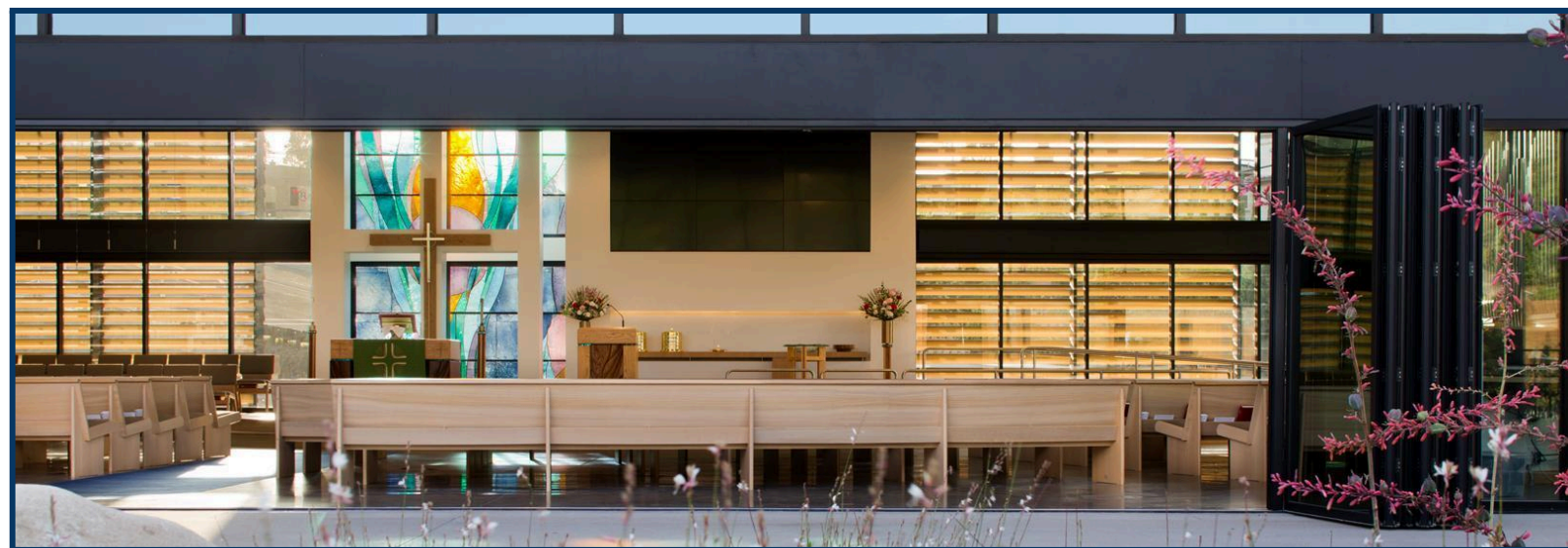

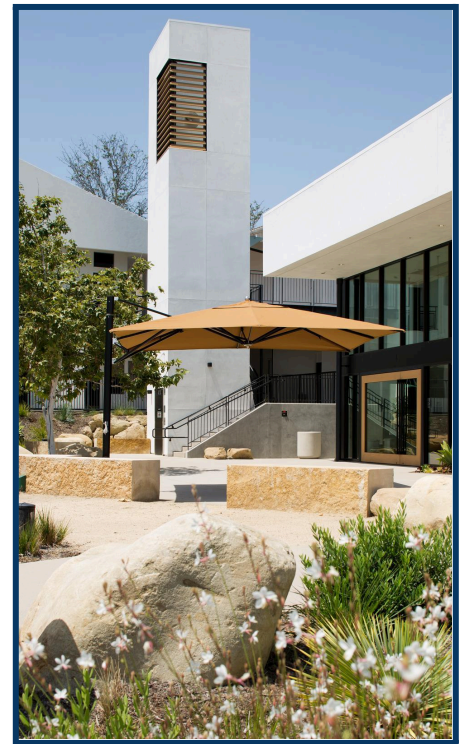
DEI-LY SERVICE

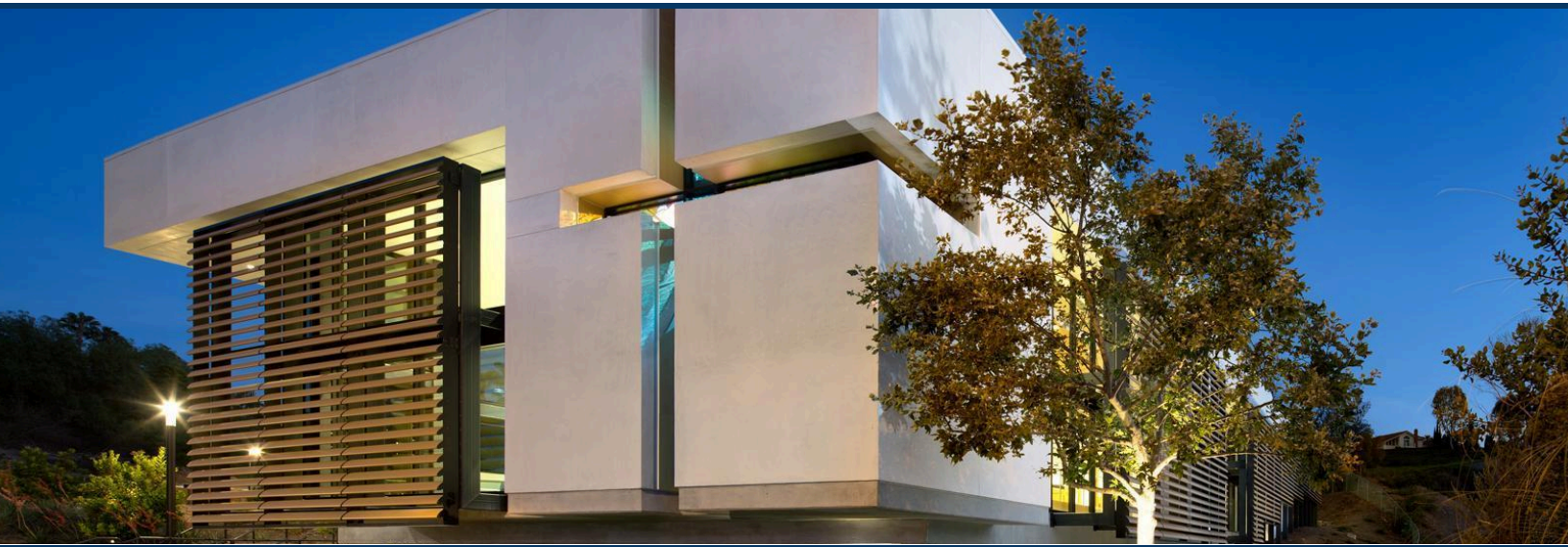

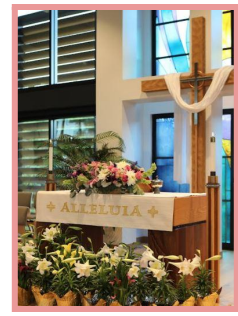
