## FUNERAL/MEMORIAL ORDER OF SERVICE

(There is some flexibility in this order of service, but generally, this order reflects the celebration of God's love for the person and is fitting for a service within Gloria Dei's sanctuary. If you have questions, please speak with a pastor ahead of time.)

## **PRELUDE**

THE WELCOME (This is a brief welcome, announcements, and introduction to the service given by the pastor.)

THE HYMN (Hymns and songs may be chosen by the family that are fitting for a Christian service.)

THE PRAYER OF THE DAY

THE READINGS (These can be from both the Old or New Testament. See handout.)

SPECIAL MUSIC/HYMN (Optional - A favorite hymn may be sung here or a solo or instrumental piece.)

THE HOLY GOSPEL (The pastor and family select this and it reflects the eternal hope of Christ.)

EULOGIES (1 or 2 Eulogies may be given. Eulogy means "good words." Often this is a family member or close friend. The pastor will speak with the family about the Eulogies.)

THE HYMN/SONG

THE MESSAGE (This is a brief homily/message given by the pastor.)

THE HYMN/SPECIAL MUSIC (All of the special music is optional.)

PRAYERS OF THE CHURCH (Lord in Your Mercy. **Hear our prayer.**)

THE LORD'S PRAYER

THE COMMENDATION (The pastor offers a final commendation of the person to God)

TOLLING OF THE BELLS (12x representing the church on earth and in heaven.)

THE BENEDICTION

THE SENDING HYMN

POSTLUDE (Often the family is ushered out during the Sending Hymn or during the Postlude music to greet people on the patio.)

(The Order of Service is a template. Please speak with the pastor or other church staff about other options during preliminary meetings.)
