THANKSLIVING!

Opportunity for those 70½ years and older - You can give any amount (maximum of \$105,000) this year from your IRA directly to Gloria Dei without having to pay income taxes on the money. Gifts of any value \$105,000 or less are eligible for this benefit. This popular gift option is called the IRA charitable rollover, or qualified charitable distribution, or QCD. You pay no income taxes on the gift. The transfer generates neither taxable income nor a tax deduction, so you benefit even if you do not itemize deductions. Since the gift doesn't count as income, it can reduce your annual income. This may help lower your Medicare premiums and decrease the amount of Social Security that is subject to tax. Something to consider!

The tour included museum admission, guided tour to areas not open to the public with a docent, and a cafeteria style lunch in their 100 year old dining room. 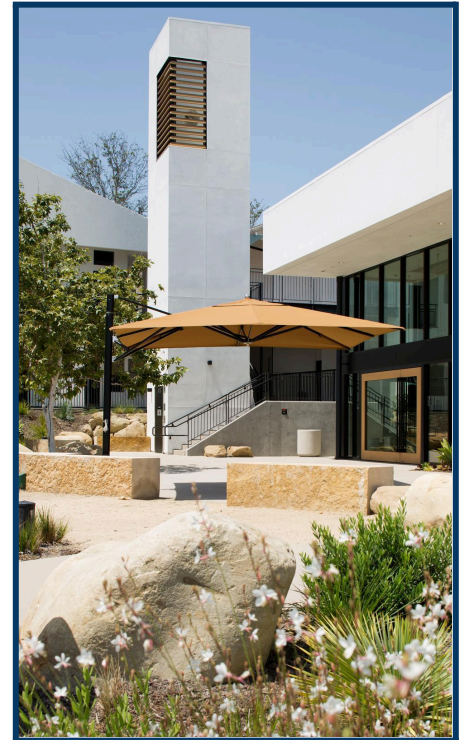

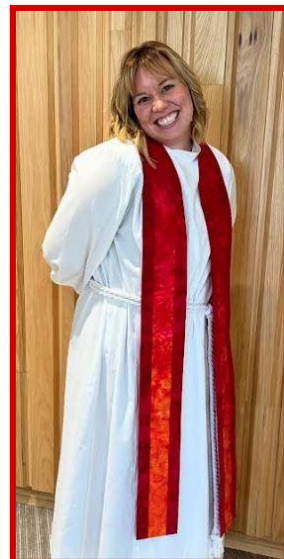
