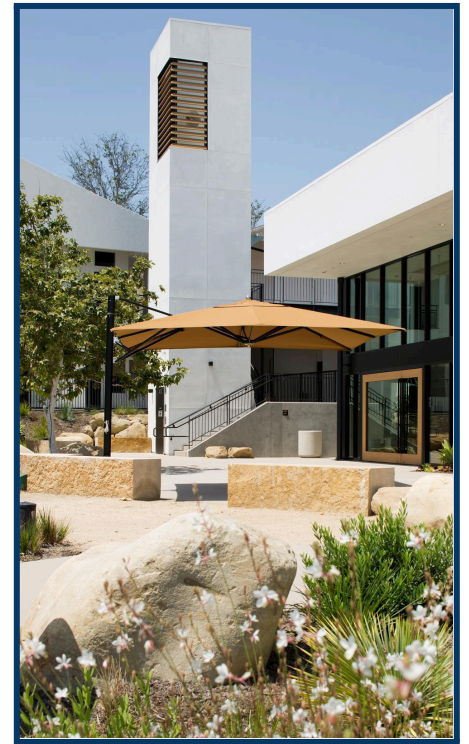
We did it! Gloria Dei raised the money to get much needed dental work for three of the children at the Los Angelitos Orphanage. The work will be done by a dentist
