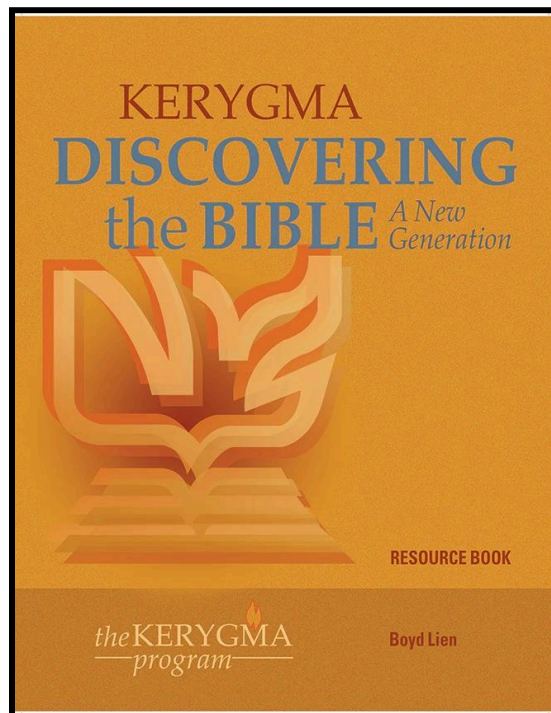

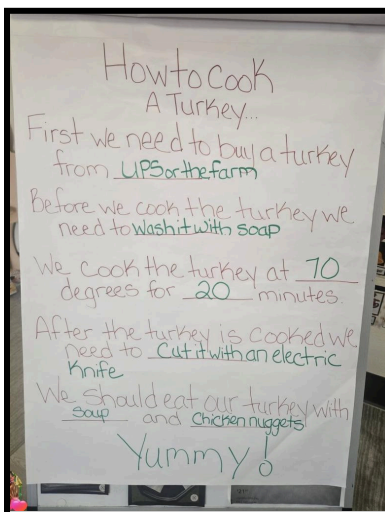

LOS ANGELITOS ORPHANAGE MINISTRY -

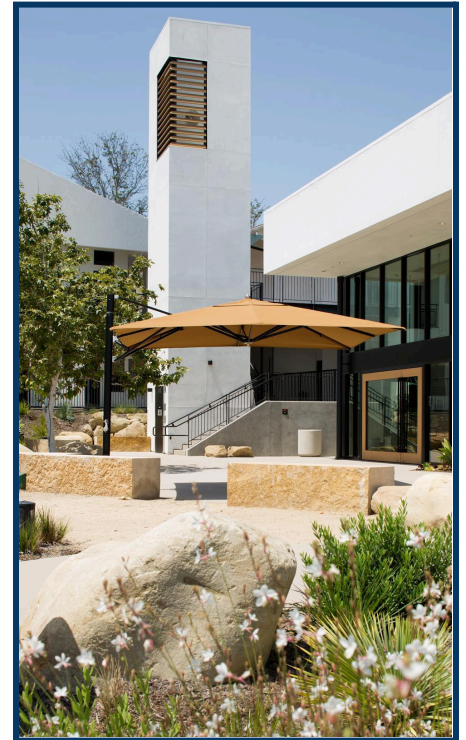

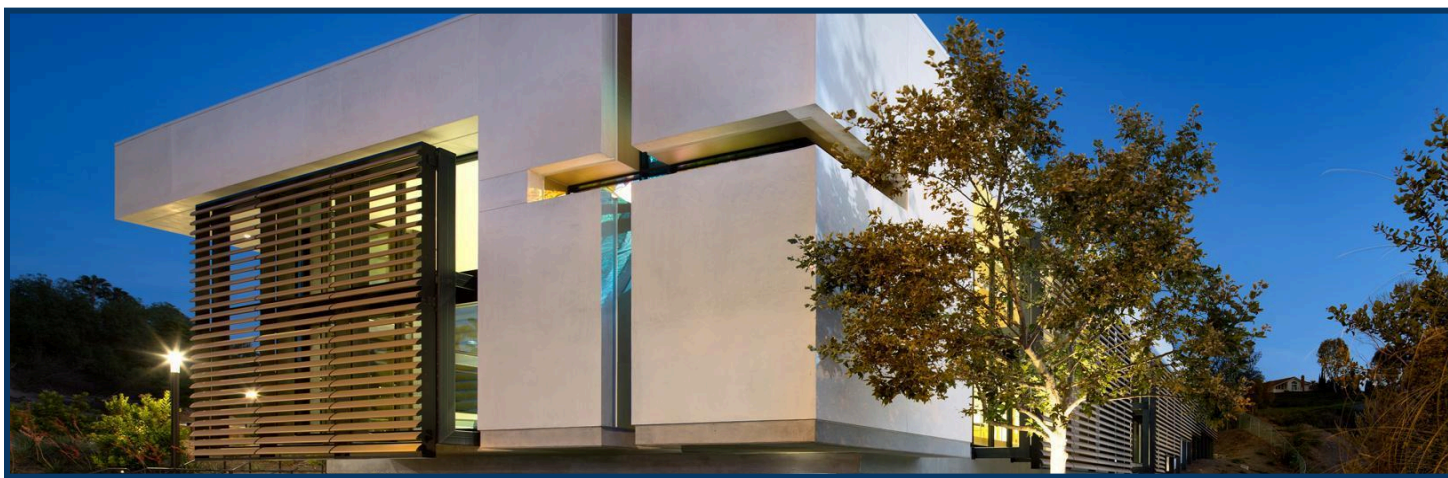
